After heading up EMEA High Education, Alan Greenberg became Apple's Head of Education in Asia and then moved on to Head of Higher Education in the UK. A business development and marketing specialist, Greenberg was one of the early pioneers of the EdTech industry. Through Apple EMEA he managed podcasting support programs and was an instrumental figure in Apple Education's 'iTunes Universities' roll out in Europe – enabling teachers to customise class experiences by using iPads and iTunes U as tools to enhance and improve teaching.

As Director at CareerFoundry, Greenberg has the opportunity to expand on these past experiences. Through development of new initiatives to change the way tech is taught by teachers, there can be improved learning outcomes for students. By ensuring every child can learn how to code and that teachers across the globe can access online resources, mentoring and support to teach them, CareerFoundry is educating the next generation of programmers. Greenberg explains:

"CareerFoundry is the first startup I've come across with the courage to truly embrace change in the learning of computing skills in schools, and to do so in such a fundamentally new and exciting way".
