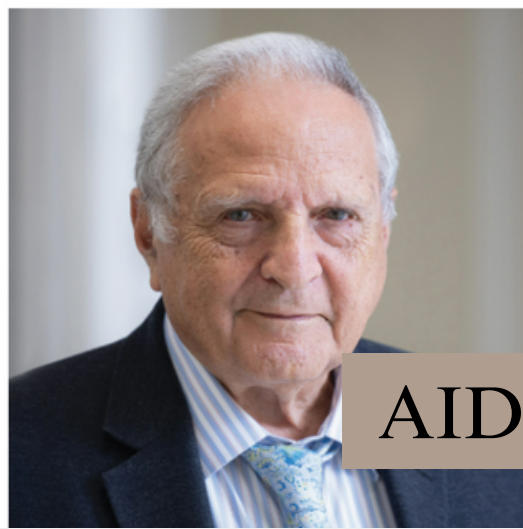


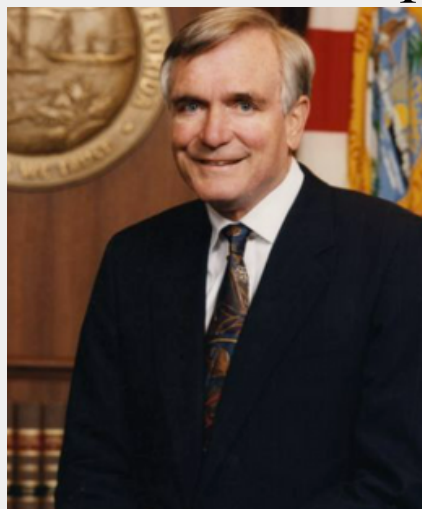
NYT published a piece about an emerging kind of cancer, titled it “gay cancer”. (Altman, 1981)



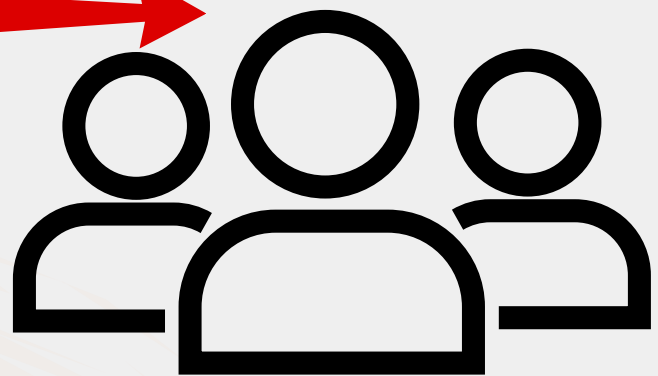
NYT publishes a piece in which they call this illness “GRID” (Gay Related Immune Deficiency) (Altman, 1982)



Dr. Arye Rubinstein's medical discoveries get dismissed (Hopkins Tanne, 2008)



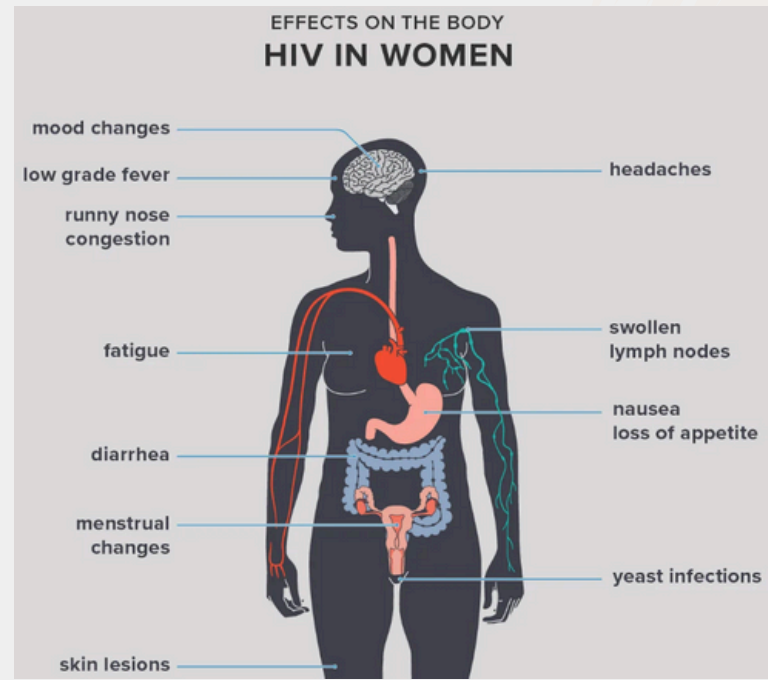
Senator Lawton Chiles dismisses AIDS as anything other than a “gay disease” (Patterson, 2017)

CDC study including Gaetan Dugas gets published (McKay R. A., 2014)



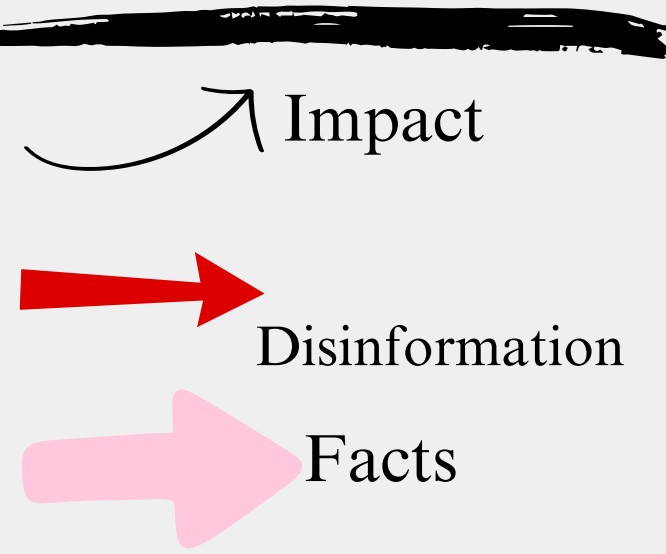
