If you want a quick answer, here's what you need to know:

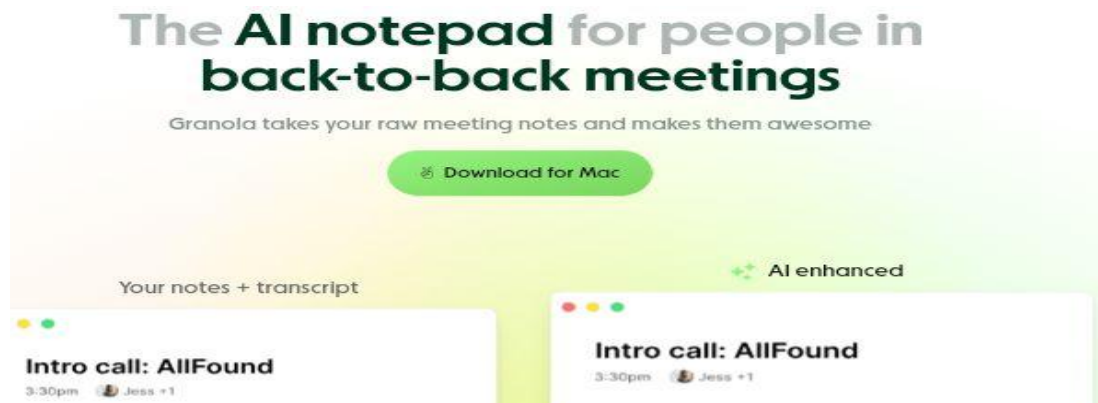
- Granola is **best for professionals who are in a lot of back-to-back meetings and want to stay on top of all conversations, action items, and follow-ups without getting overwhelmed.**

Granola:



Granola is an AI note-taker or meeting assistant that help individuals and teams take notes during meetings and provides an AI-enhanced summary to help users stay on top of meetings without missing anything important. Its features help users stay fully focused and present, and reduces the chance of missing any major detail during meetings.

Granola offers **accurate transcriptions** that records every meeting word for word. It also allows you to jot down some notes while the meeting is going on and even ‘chat’ with the transcript.

At the end of your meeting, it merges your notes with the transcript to create an **AI-enhanced summary** that contains highlights of the meeting, speaker identification i.e who said what and action items from the meeting.

You can get this summary in the customized templates provided by Granola like 1:1 template, customer discovery templates, etc or you can create your personalized template. This ensures that you get notes in a format that fits your workflow and makes follow-ups and reviews easier, reducing the need to edit.

Not only do you get a clear task list from this summary, you can also handle your **post-meeting tasks** like follow-up emails, asking questions, etc, as it can share notes on Slack, emails, keeping everyone on your team aligned.

With Granola, you can focus on your meetings knowing fully well that every important detail is being recorded and organized and you would not miss anything.

Also, there is **no meeting bot joining your meetings** as Granola runs quietly in the background. So, say goodbye to awkward permissions to record and enjoy a non-intrusive and private meeting.

- **Limited Access:** Granola only works for iPhone/Mac and recently windows. You can't access it from an android phone. It also doesn't allow web/browser access. Also, the iPhone version only works for in-person conversations.
- **Google-Only Integration:** Granola only works for Google accounts. It doesn't work for Microsoft outlook.
- **Limited Free Plan Benefits:** The free plan of Granola is limited to 25 meetings which might not be enough for regular users/teams.

Otter



Otter is an AI note-taker that helps users record their virtual and in-person meetings and get live transcripts and organized summaries, making sure they stay updated on every important points in a meeting. It also helps users and teams collaborate on meeting notes, ensuring everyone is aligned.

Otter offers **live and accurate transcriptions** of meetings while it is going on. These transcriptions contain speaker identification so you can always know what each speaker said. It also allows users to chat with the transcript and search for key points.

Otter also provides users with an **organized summary** of long meeting transcripts containing highlighted sections, important details and action items. It can assign action items to each meeting participant ensuring everyone knows what their task is. So, at the end of the meeting, Otter automatically sends transcripts and summaries to every meeting member, improving team collaboration.

It also offers **AI chat feature** that helps you chat with meeting notes and do post-meeting stuff like follow-up emails, generating blog posts, status updates, etc. This helps you quickly find answers without re-watching the whole meeting. It also automates post-meeting tasks saving your time and effort.

Another major feature of Otter is the **AI channels** feature where team members can discuss with themselves and Otter AI about the meeting and other project. So, like a slack channel but in Otter and you chat with not just your team members but with Otter AI too.

This helps teams keep conversations in one place and speed up decision-making and follow-up after meetings. No need to move to another tool to discuss the meeting or make post-meeting plans.

Otter also has a **meeting bot** that joins meetings and takes notes while the meeting is going on. This ensures that no information is missed during note-taking.

It also integrates with CRM and analytics tools like HubSpot, Salesforce, Egnyte, Amazon S3, Snowflake, and Microsoft SharePoint, etc.

- **Meeting Bots:** The presence of Otter AI bots joining meetings can feel intrusive and uncomfortable. It can also be awkward having to take permission to record.
- **Automatic Meeting Recordings:** Otter can automatically record, join and even send transcripts to call attendees or participants without your permission which can be difficult to disable or turn off.
- **Poor Customer Service:** Users of Otter have complained on [multiple platforms](#) about the slow response of Otter customer support. This may be a major challenge especially when you need urgent help.
- **Limited Free Plan Benefits:** The free plan has a limit of 30 minutes per conversation which may not be suitable for users and teams who hold long meetings.
