They encounter hiring discrimination and racial stereotypes



struggle to find suitable
housing due to landlords who
refuse to rent to black
tenants.
forced to accept substandard
living conditions.

They frequently encounter everyday acts of racism, such as racial slurs, derogatory comments, and micro aggressions.



### INVISIBILITY

the inability to be seen or the state of being ignored or not taken into consideration.
