capture visually appealing photos.



Images are best captured using natural light. Light illuminates the subject. Make sure that you are not shooting the subject against the light source.



Try shooting from different perspectives.
Shooting the subject from a slightly lower angle gives us a different view from the usual eye level that we are used to.





Shooting from high up gives a better perspective - compare with same subjects on the left.



An eye level perspective may not be as clear as change of perspective



Filling the frame gives better detail



Mind the headroom and the noseroom
