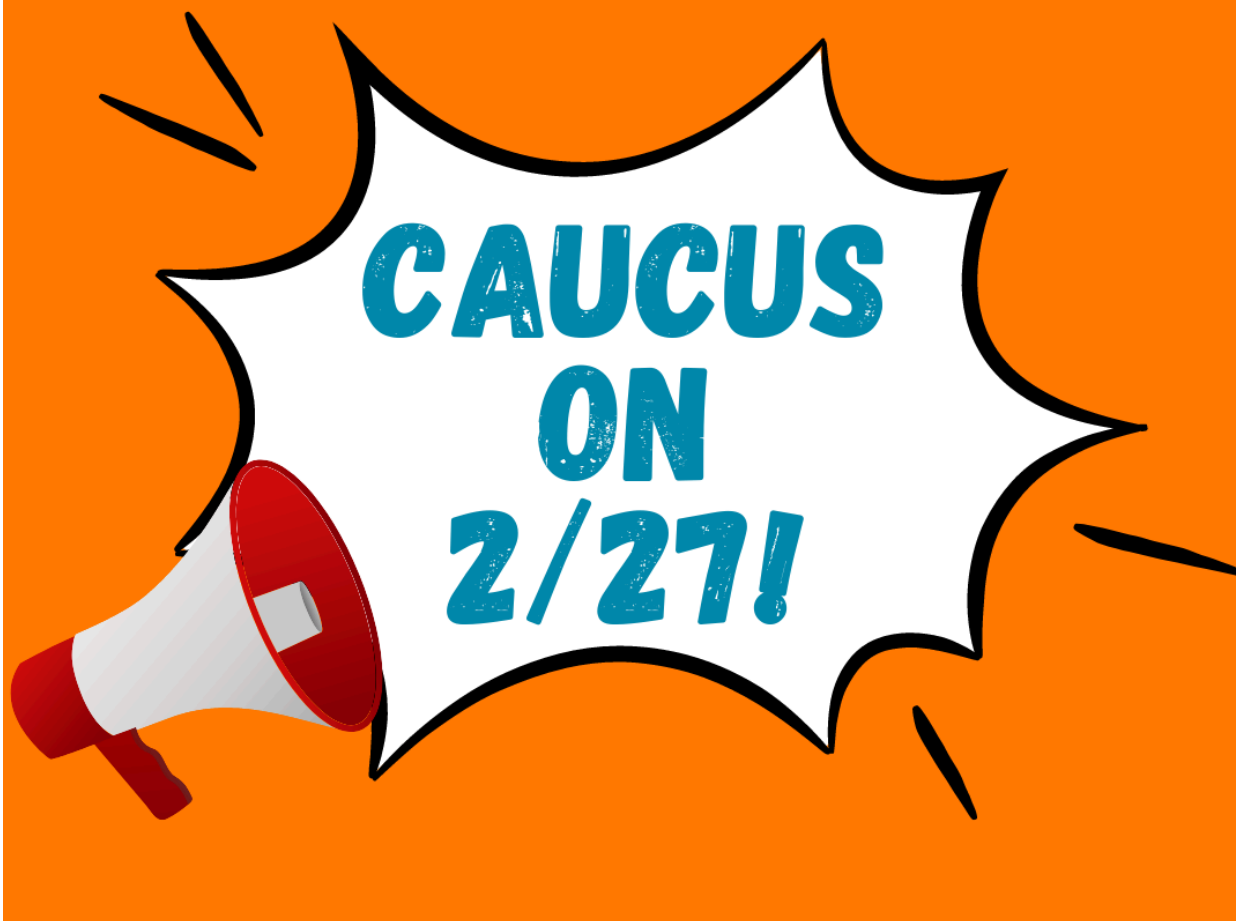


Want to be a

The caucuses are coming, and I need your support! I'm hearing rumors that a couple of men are thinking about challenging me for the DFL nomination. With your participation as a delegate for Senate District 4, I can earn the DFL's support to run for this seat again and continue my work in the legislature.

Here's the TL;DR: Come to the caucus on 2/27 at the MSUM CMU at 6:30 pm. Tell the people at the registration table where you live, and they'll tell you which room to go to. Volunteer to be a delegate or alternate at the county or Senate District convention. If you still want to support me but you can't attend in person, fill out this form and in section 4 choose Senate District delegate

or alternate.

Now here's the long version.

What are caucuses?

The caucuses are where you meet with neighbors in your precinct and discuss important party business. You'll introduce and vote on resolutions that could make their way all the way to the national Democratic Party platform. You will also elect delegates to the county convention and the Senate District convention, where I will be running to be endorsed by the DFL to run again for House District 4A.

When are they?

February 27. Registration opens at 6:30 pm, and the caucuses must begin at 7 pm by Minnesota law. They typically last for about an hour.

Where are they?

Our precinct caucuses will be at the Comstock Memorial Union at MSUM. When you register, you'll be directed to the right room for your precinct. You can find your precinct number here: <https://caucusfinder.sos.state.mn.us/>

Why should I go?

You should go if:

- you want to be a delegate to the Senate District convention so you can vote to endorse me for my House District 4A race.
- you want to be a delegate to the state or national convention.
- you are passionate about an issue that you want to be included or changed in the DFL or national Democratic Party platform.
- you want to meet other Democrats in your neighborhood.

What happens after the caucus?

Delegates elected at the caucus will attend the Senate District convention in Barnesville on the afternoon of Saturday, April 27 to vote to endorse me. If you think it's at all possible that you might be able to do this, please attend your precinct caucus, or send in the non-attendee form.
