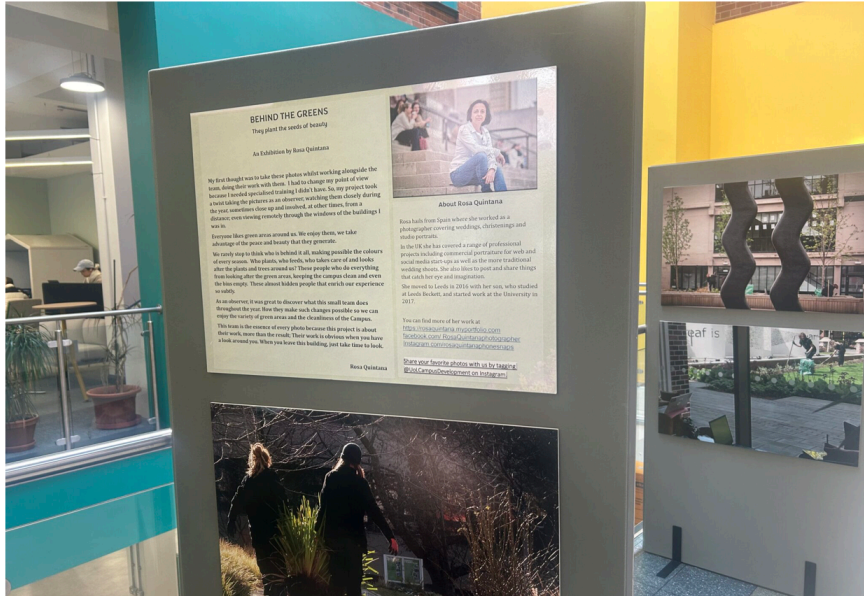


'Behind the Greens:' University of Leeds Cleaner Shares her Photography in Exhibition

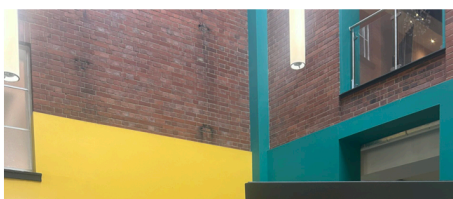

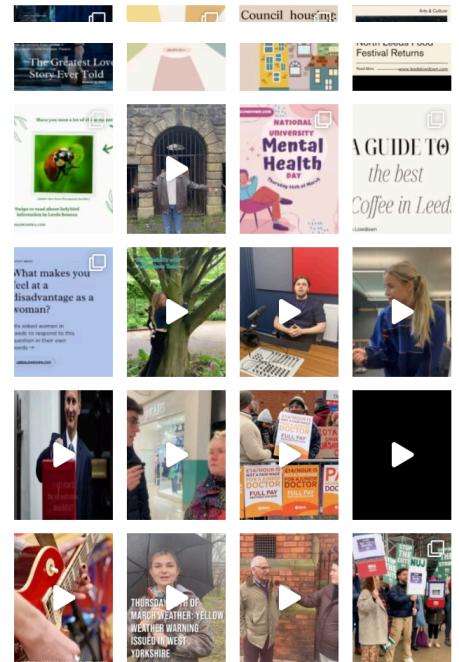
National University Mental Health Day returns to Leeds

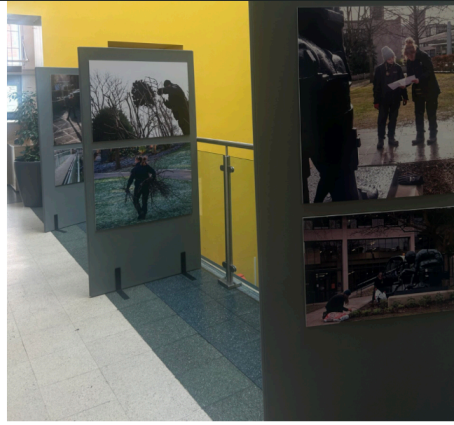
