## AT HOME VS PROFESSIONAL PRINTING


What are the advantages of printing professionally instead of printing at home, especially for small wineries?

here are several important advantages to printing professionally:

At home printing is done in sheets and the labels need to be applied by hand, instead of a commercial roll that can be applied with a special applicator. Applying labels by hand is not only cumbersome and time-consuming, it's also not the ideal quality. There is simply no way to achieve a uniform look for all the bottles in a lot by hand-applying the labels. In other words, the results will not look as professional and sophisticated with self-printing options.

Home printing options don't allow printing with different types of paper, so the client won't be able to do special label decoration finishes such as foil stamping, embossing, metallic inks. Samples are available upon request to see for those wondering what these options look like.

There may also be alignment issues and waste of material with self-printing.

## Which print method delivers the best quality?

lexo & Waterless Offset are usually best for high-end-looking labels (depending on how the artwork is built).

These require setup and plates, but Waterless Offset is viewed throughout the industry as a offering the finest print detail. Flexographic printing offers excellent label color consistency, and is ideal for working with metallic inks. If a client really wants a high end label, Vintage 99 may recommend Waterless Offset, if it will work well with their particular artwork. At Vintage 99, a label expert will study the label artwork and recommend the best printing option. Some artwork does better with Flexographic or Digital, but some can only be done as Offset. Waterless Offset provides vibrant color reproduction, and like flexographic printing, is most cost effective for print runs of 50,000 labels or more. Digital printing is an excellent option for print runs of less than 50,000 labels. There are no plate costs or press setup fees, and the resulting print is finely detailed even with intricate designs. With digital printing, clients can often achieve high quality printing with maximum cost effectieness. The great news is that Vintage 99 has all three technologies, and can do whichever is best for the artwork and the client's particular needs.








## Types of papers

Paper is the canvas of every label. Choosing the right paper or substrate is important to achieving the right look and feel with any label.

Uncoated papers like those listed below give great contrast to shiny finishing options like foil and gloss varnish while coated papers and smooth substrates like BOPP give excellent ink reflectivity and color saturation.




## Pristine Felt Paper

Pristine Felt was developed to be THE perfect label paper, and since its release it has quickly become Vintage 99's most popular option. At 80lb, it is one of the thickest uncoated papers on the market which gives great felt texture detail and feels upscale when touched.

This paper also excels at resisting moisture and wetness when put into an ice bucket or refrigerated so the label maintains its bright white color without getting gray when saturated with moisture.

## The Vintage 99 Process

Vintage 99 uses a 7-step process to ensure quality and efficiency for each label order. This streamlined system helps customers receive the highest quality labels quickly and easily. Here's how it works:



### Start With a Price Quote

The best place to start with a custom label project is to have Vintage 99's label experts prepare a label quote based on the choice of decoration options, available artwork, and the quantity of labels needed. Call to discuss a quote or use the Request for Quote Page to complete an online request. An account manager will be assigned to the project and contact the client to review all options and pricing in detail.





Once an estimate is completed and reviewed, an account manager will help the client setup an account if they haven't ordered with Vintage 99 before.

They will provide an order confirmation that outlines all pricing, plates and tooling needed along with other important details for the client to review and approve.



## Review Label Proofs

After the order details are confirmed and approved, PDF proofs of the artwork are created to show how the label will look. These are the perfect tools for letting the rest of the client's team review the final design before production starts. Proofs show in detail which parts of the label have special finishing effects and where areas of texture will be.



#### **Approve Color**

If a label project uses custom colors or has special elements that need to be verified, the account manager will schedule a press check so that someone from the client's team can see the label printed before we print the entire order. In some cases, a press proof will be used or Vintage 99 may ask for approval to match color on the client's behalf, also known as a press check waiver.



## The Vintage 99 Process

**Production & QA**Prior to the label being printed, Vintage 99 Quality Assurance team verifies that all printed copy matches your approved proofs and that color approval has been received. Once printing begins, samples are taken at pre-determined intervals and kept for reference. The on-press defectins pection systems also scan every label and flag any defects to the QAteam, allowing even a single label to be replaced if it is flagged tobe out of spec.

### Your Order Is Shipped

Once printed and released from QA, the order is packed per the roll specifications needed and boxed for shipping. Vintage 99 uses a variety of freight carriers and also operates their own trucks for direct delivery.



## Vintage 99 Lead Times

## Is there an average lead time for labels already designed by the client?

he average leadtime is 15 working days. Special orders of paper can extend the leadtime an additional two weeks. Vintage 99 can get a project done in as little as two weeks for urgent runs, because their lead times are some of the shortest in the business. This has really helped Vintage 99 weather the supply chain issues currently affecting the industry. However, a better time estimate for a particular project can be provided once your sales representative knows exactly what you need. Please contact Vintage 99 for a free consultation to determine how quickly your order can be processed.

Most of our design packages featured on page 24 require an additional 4 weeks to complete the design and make the files ready for printing.

# What is the minimum amount of labels required to place an order?

The total minimum order size is 1000 labels, multiple label versions can make up this total.



## **Label Pricing Options**

# Which printing option is more cost effective?

t primarily depends on the size of the order. For orders less than 50,000 labels in total, digital is usually the lowest cost option since the time to setup the press is low and there are no printing plate costs. On orders 50,000 labels or more, Flexographic printing can be less cost than Digital printing since Flexographic reduces in cost over time once the press is setup and running. Therefore the larger the order is, the lower the label cost becomes. Waterless Offset is also good for larger runs of 100,000 and above for the same reasons as Flexographic printing.

Digital printing is typically less costly for orders of less than 50,000 labels.

#### Separates:


Front labels are on one roll.




Bottlers Statement characters 2 mm minimum.
