Overview of Non-surgical Treatment Options

We offer several <u>non-surgical treatment options</u> through our accredited clinics. The procedure that is most therapeutic for you will be determined during your consultation with one of our vein specialists.

<u>Endovenous Laser Vein Treatment (ELVT)</u>. Also known as endovenous laser ablation (EVLA), this ultrasound-guided laser procedure for varicose veins is considered the gold standard. This non-surgical procedure involves heat from inserting the laser into the vein, which causes it to close off. This procedure has a high success rate and may reduce the risk of developing other severe health conditions.

Varithena Vein Treatment. This procedure treats varicose veins by injecting a special varithena foam. An ultrasound-guided catheter is placed into the diseased vein. The microfoam collapses and seals the vein, redirecting blood flow to healthy veins.

<u>Ultrasound-guided sclerotherapy.</u> Ultrasound-guided sclerotherapy treats superficial varicose veins on the skin surface. A chemical called sclerosant purposely irritates the diseased vein, which then collapses and closes off.

<u>ClariVein</u>. ClariVein is a minimally invasive, ultrasound-guided treatment using a special catheter to deliver the medication. It is unique because it requires no anesthetic or incisions and can often be completed within 30 minutes.

Vensaseal. VenaSeal uses a catheter to apply a specially prepared medical adhesive into the diseased veins. This adhesive closes the varicose veins and reroutes blood flow. Compression socks are typically not needed after the VenaSeal treatment.

Radiofrequency Ablation (RFA). This safe and effective procedure treats varicose veins by applying energy from radio waves instead of laser heat. Patients often notice a gradual improvement in their symptoms over several days.

<u>Visual Sclerotherapy Spider Vein Treatment</u>. Vein disease can also result in spider veins. During visual sclerotherapy, a vein specialist injects a sclerosant into the tiny diseased vessel to treat spider veins. Due to their superficial nature, this is usually guided by sight rather than ultrasound.
