The ink of Yeah I Know (Y.I.K. for short), is etched into my forehead, a permanent query, a silent dialogue with the world.

It's a declaration of uncertainty, a recognition of the infinite unknown.

This three-letter acronym, is a linguistic parasite, a phrase so overused it has lost its meaning most of the time a preamble of just about the opposite. Yet, it persists, a verbal tic, a conversational crutch. My forehead tattoo is a **rebellion** against this linguistic complacency, a challenge to the superficiality of such facile agreement.

I've always been drawn to the indelible nature of tattoos.

As a child, I experimented by "tattooing" my toys, a precursor to a lifelong fascination. My teenage rebellion manifested in my first tattoo, a bold statement against my family's disapproval. [my first tattoo was my entire back done as soon as I was legally entitled to have one (18 years old)]. It was a rite of passage, a mark of independence.

By the <u>age of twenty</u>, I was already experimenting with the tattoo machine and just with the needles (handpoke), driven by an innate desire to create, transform, embed and seal.

Over four years of dedicated practice, I honed my craft, transitioning from amateur enthusiast to skilled artist.

The opening of my 1st Berlin studio marked the beginning of a new chapter, a professional journey that would span $\underline{\text{seven intense}}$ years.

Tattoo conventions, guest spots, and the adrenaline rush of the creative process fueled my passion.

However, the relentless pace eventually took its toll, prompting a necessary hiatus to focus on data analysis.

 $\underline{\text{My tattoo style}}$ is an eclectic $\underline{\text{fusion}}$ of the $\underline{\text{conventional}}$ and the $\underline{\text{avant-garde.}}$

It's a visual language that speaks to the complexity of the human experience.

Some designs are minimalist, almost brutally simple, while others are intricate labyrinths of symbolism.

Each tattoo is a unique alchemy, a blend of blood, ink, time, and intention.

It's a form of artistic expression that transcends time, a permanent imprint on a transient body.

I believe that every tattoo has a destined wearer.

With over **400 designs** in <u>search of an owner</u> and approximately **300** brought to life, my portfolio is a testament to a relentless creative spirit.



This initiative was born out of necessity: transforming my tattoo designs into digital prints.

I'm also open to commissions, offering limited edition digital prints. Here's how it works: I create ten prints of each design, available in four sizes—A5, A4, A3, and A2.

Each size starts at a predetermined price, and with every purchase, the price of the remaining prints doubles.

This system rewards early buyers, as the first print is sold at the starting price.

By the time the tenth print of the same design is sold, its price will have significantly increased and will be never printed again.

This means that the initial purchaser, who took a chance on the design,

receives a print that has a compounding value. It's my way of thanking them for their belief in my work.

The concept behind this strategy is to create exclusivity and reward those for who support my art from the beginning.

As the prints become scarcer and more expensive, their value as unique pieces of art increases. This approach not only makes the art more desirable but also acknowledges and appreciates early adopters.

I want each print to carry a story, not just through its design but also through its journey from the first to the tenth purchase.


The first buyer's print, bought at the original price, will be as valuable as the final one sold, despite the price difference.

I sought out the most distinctive pieces I could find, gradually amassing a rich and diverse wardrobe. My fashion choices became increasingly adventurous. I experimented with everything from dressing as a fox or Stitch from Disney to embodying a soldier, ninja, samurai, handyman, or even a time traveler from the future.

This eclectic mix of styles eventually evolved into my current preference for wearing a **blazer**.

Why do I share this journey? Because it is the foundation of my concept: dIG bICK.

In essence, "I DIG BICK YOU!" captures the spirit of <u>creating unique</u> outfits or pieces from scraps or by enhancing existing items, each time building a story and a distinctive collection.

I relish the freedom to create pieces from raw fabric and materials, infusing each with a sense of individuality and creativity.




