



Create a New Snowflake Connection

1. Login to Scitara DLX™ and open the Connections menu item. Locate the Snowflake Connector.



2. Click the plus (+) sign on the Connector tile to launch the “Create new Snowflake Connection” wizard.
3. Alternatively, click on the Connector tile to open the Connector properties page then click the (+) sign to launch the “Create new Snowflake Connection” wizard.



4. Click **NEXT** on step 1 of the new Connection creation wizard. Complete all wizard steps thereafter.





7. In step 3 of the wizard, click **FINISH** to create your Snowflake Connection.




Your new Connection will appear. Verify that the Connection is online, however, additional configuration is required.



Configure the Snowflake Connection

1. To configure your Connection settings, click on the Connection tile. The settings button will appear, and is indicated by the red-exclamation point:



2. Enter your Snowflake account details here. You will need:
 - a. **Account Identifier:** This is the account name within your organization or its region-based locator
 - b. **Username:** Your username used to access the Snowflake account
 - c. **Password:** Your password used to access the Snowflake account.
