Leeds toddler saves mum's life after she suffered a heart attack

A MUM has hailed her four-year-old son as a hero after he saved her life when she collapsed with a heart attack.

Kadell Anderson-Brown of Leeds contacted paramedics over the

phone and, although terrified, he managed to give his full address and phone number to the 999 call handler.

The incident caused damage to her heart, but medics admit that

were it not for her son's amazing actions, she may not have made it.

Mawena suffers from a condition known as hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, a genetic

condition that affects the heart and can result in sudden death.

Mawena explained: "He was very worried, he kept crying and saying 'please don't die mummy'. It makes me cry every time I think about it. At the time he was so worried, it was scary to see him like that."

"He said 'It's all right, mummy, I only wanted to make you better'."
