## No penalty for Leeds-Bradford Airport night noise breaches

No legal action will be taken against Leeds Bradford Airport (LBA) despite it having breached night flight rules for a second summer, a council has said.

Leeds City Council said while too many flights had run outside regular hours again last summer, the "public interest test" for a prosecution was not met.

A breach of condition notice was originally issued by Leeds City Council to

LBA in June last year after an investigation found it had exceeded the number

of permitted night-time movements by 25% during the 2022 summer season. As part of this notice, the airport agreed to not operate more than 2,920 night flights between 23:00 BST and 07:00 BST during future summer seasons.

However, the number of night flights at LBA during the 2023 summer season was 3,497, the council has confirmed.
