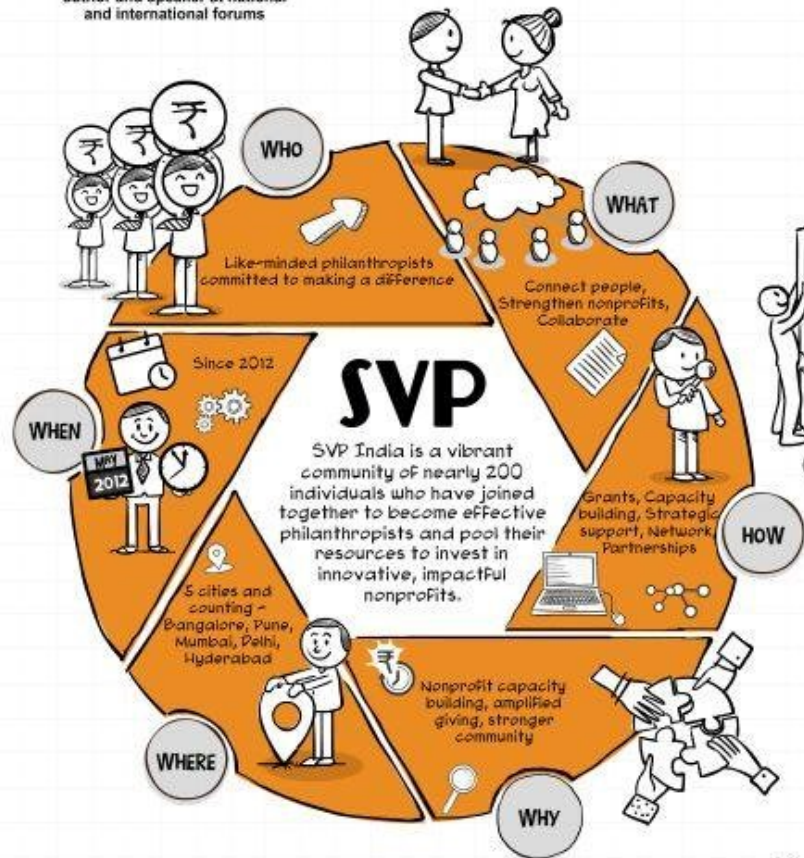
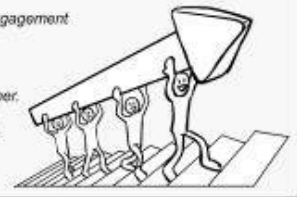
**Redefining our trust with destiny!**
