Join us Thursday, July 25, for the second day of the Ohio State Fair! Starting at 10 a.m., enjoy plenty of activities everyone can enjoy including free live music, livestock exhibitions, thrilling performances, demonstrations, rides, games and so much more.

Here's what you can find at the Fair today:

## Sensory Friendly Morning & Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Day:

We've turned down the lights and volume to make the Ohio State Fair more sensory-friendly in partnership with OCALI. Ride the rides with no flashing lights or music, visit the Fair's many educational and sensory activities, take a break in a quiet room or use our accessibility guide to find a Fair opportunity that suits you. Print social narratives, a first-then board, and wait cards are also available on OCALI's website. Visit the Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities mobile unit to talk with staff about services and where to find accessibility features at the Fair such as wheelchair charging stations, universal changing tables, service animal relief areas and American Sign Language interpreting. Kids can create a craft spelling out their names using ASL stamps and learn about the built-in accessibility tools on smartphones.

#### WOSU Kids Day:

Join WOSU Public Media in Central Park from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. for a chance to meet some of your favorite PBS KIDS® characters! The event, designed to keep the whole family entertained, will offer PBS KIDS® crafts, coloring, educational activities, and games. See PBS KIDS® characters throughout the day for photo opportunities.

#### It's \$3 Thursday:

Try some of the Fair's best deep-fried treats, classic dishes, and innovative creations for just \$3! Both Thursdays of the Fair, food vendors will be offering a menu item of their choice at a smaller size for just \$3. ### **FREE Live Music:**

- Soulful singer **Theo Perry** is known for his skills on the guitar. This Columbus resident, who is originally from Cleveland, is also a recording artist and live performer. Be sure to catch his guitar skills live at noon and 2 p.m. on the Wellcare Gazebo Stage.

He continues to impress and excite audiences with his stage show through combining elements of storytelling, live-looping-creating landscapes of sound, and all out rocking! #### **Cooking Demonstrations:**

Also in Kasich Hall B, you can catch Blue Ribbon Baker Karri Perry demonstrate how to make her Best of Show Cheese Bread from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.

Don't miss the opportunity to watch some of the top amatuer boxers in the region compete against one another right here on the Fairgrounds. The action will begin at 6 p.m. in Kasich Hall A, with the competition continuing on July 26 and 27.
