Audience Engagement Strategy

- Enhanced reach to target audiences with simple explanations of complex topics, such as a series about literacy directed at parents and lawmakers, who then added \$8M to the state budget for personnel and testing.
- Monitored government and scientific reports, set up search alerts, and used other reporting methods to deliver stories to engage core audience of parents, including dangers of 3D printer exhaust, performance of private school vouchers, accelerated school hiring, test cheating, guns in schools, and vaping risks.
- Engaged teacher audience by identifying relevant stories, delivering articles about how they were
 deprioritized for pandemic vaccine access and how they then left state for vaccination.
- Promoted company brand, credibility, and reach by hosting live events, moderating televised candidate debates, and appearing on TV and radio news programs to provide subject matter expertise.

Writing and Editing

- Wrote award-winning stories about an Atlanta mayor's homeless father, undocumented child laborers in a poultry-processing plant, and the murder of a local prosecutor; coverage of school censorship conflict was finalist for an Atlanta Press Club award in 2023.
- Wrote articles with impact, causing donations to offset school lunch debt and influencing lawmakers to amend a dangerous school bus stop law.
