Creative Writing Lesson Plans: Pitch

Theme: World

The theme for the lessons are all about encouraging the kids to create their own world. It doesn't have to literally be an entire planet, it can be a village, a city, a continent, a universe, but it has to be something the kid created themselves.

The first day we would start with creating the world and seeing what they come up with, then build on those ideas throughout the quarter.

Younger Kids:

The main goal is to focus on creating something. To help write down the ideas they have.

<u>Plants</u>: Let's work together to figure out what plants exist in your world. Plants can have a variety of colors and do many different things. What do they look like? How do they taste? Are any of them dangerous? Are some of them rare?

<u>Travel</u>: How do people get from place to place in your world? It doesn't have to just be humans; it can be animals too. Do they use horses, cars, spaceships, more? <u>Fashion</u>: What kinds of clothes to people wear? What does it look like? Do some people wear some clothes, and other people wear different ones? And why?

Older Kids:

For older kids, dig deeper and figure out how their world works and conflicts could exist.

<u>Fauna and Flora</u>: What kind of plants exist in your world? Let's work to try and see how these plants helped change and grow your world. Do they gain energy through photosynthesis like our world, or no? Do some of them do unique things in your world? <u>Transportation</u>: Since it's a driving force in our world, how does the ability to move from place-to-place work in yours? On a bigger scale how does it work, and on a smaller scale? What is more common, and what's less common?

<u>Fabrics</u>: What kinds of clothes do people wear, and what is it made out of? How does it change based on wealth, or gender identity? How about climate or work?
