We hope this email finds you well. As Open Enrollment arrives, we would like to notify you of your (Plan D) Medicare Prescription Plan options. As you may already know, benefits and prescription costs are subject to change every year, starting January 1st. This year, Open Enrollment will occur from October 15th to December 7th, during which time you'll be able to review or select your plan. Your options are as follows:

Option 1: Continue coverage under your current 2022 Medicare Prescription Plan. When continuing coverage, please be sure to

- Carefully review your plan's information packet to ensure you are aware of any changes that may affect the cost of prescriptions or coverage.
- Continue to use your current identification card
- Notify us via email that you are continuing with your current prescription plan

Option 2: Request a comparison between the 2023 Medicare Prescription Plan and your current plan. When choosing this option, we will provide you with

- A Medicare Prescription Plan report based on your current medications
 - This reflects your estimated prescription drug and monthly premium costs
- A comprehensive review of these findings to ensure you choose the best Medicare Prescription Plan to fit your needs
