HEY, EMPLOYEES! YOU'VE GOT DEADLINES! Of course, you know systems that interact with SAP will gradually be taken offline during the ramp-down period March 18 to March 29. The "freeze" (or blackout, as some call it) window, during which no business processes can be executed, will take place March 29 to April 4. Here's how that will affect several key systems:

- **SuccessFactors:** Employees will be unable to modify personal data or process a life event such as a marriage, birth or dependent change in SuccessFactors between March 1 and
  - April 9. If you have a life event during this period, please submit a Life Event case through the HR Portal.
- Vacation Time: Last day for submissions/approvals in the Time & Pay Portal is March 14. Employees will not be able to make retroactive changes to vacation days/hours after this date.



Concur: Last day to submit expenses is March 22.
