The Fiesta Sports Foundation is hosting the 2025 UMB Bank Fiesta Sports Foundation Football Kickoff Event on August 15. Beyond media coverage, this plan can also build long-term visibility and reinforce the Foundation's identity as a community-focused organization with its recent rebrand. By leveraging this event, we have an opportunity to strengthen relationships with supporters and local media outlets who care about making a difference.

Approach to garner media coverage for that specific media plan:

The Cronkite Agency team serving the Fiesta Sports Foundation is collaborating to conduct a targeted media approach for coverage of the UMB Bank Fiesta Sports Foundation Football Kickoff Event. This includes outreach to linear media outlets located in downtown Phoenix, local faith-based organizations to support McMahon's affiliation with BYU, and the East Valley Tribune, which has an expanded reach of coverage including Tempe, Gilbert, Mesa, and Chandler.

In addition to media outreach, the team will also explore opportunities for pre-event interviews, community calendar placements, and on-site media presence on the day of the event. These efforts aim to generate buzz leading up to August 15, drive attendance and awareness, and ensure the Foundation's philanthropic impact remains at the forefront across all coverage.
