The first step in wasp prevention is addressing the factors that attract wasps in the first place. You can remove or reduce these factors by following these three tips:

1. **Reduce Access To Water:** Start by removing standing water and clearing rain gutters. Then, make sure that hot tubs or pools are kept cleansed with cycled water.
2. **Clean Up The Yard:** Remove places where wasps like to nest by trimming trees and shrubs often. Also, remove bird feeders.

3. Remove Food Sources: Wasps are pollinators so that they will be attracted to flowering plants. Make sure not to overwater your yard.

Along with removing the things that attract wasps in Queen Creek, you can also follow a few other environmentally-friendly wasp control measures.
