



Pitt Men's Basketball Postgame Notes



Pitt vs. Louisville • Saturday, February 17, 2024

Team

- Improved to 17-8 on the season and 8-6 in ACC play with an 85-59 win over Louisville at the Petersen Events Center.
 - The Panthers have won five straight games, and seven of their last eight
 - With the win, Pitt moves up to fourth in the ACC standings
 - Pitt wins its fifth straight contest against Louisville
- Moved to 10-0 on the season and 34-2 under Jeff Capel when scoring 80 or more points in a game
- Finished shooting 46.3 percent (31-67) from the field, 48.4 percent (15-31) from three-point range, and 81 percent (9-11) from the foul line
 - The 15 made three-pointers is tied for the sixth most three-point field goals made in a contest in program history
 - Pitt has made 10 or more threes in 13 games this season
- Won the rebounding battle 36-27, including 12-2 in offensive rebounds, to improve to 14-2 on the season when outrebounding the opposition.
- Held Louisville to just 8.3 percent (1-of-12) shooting from behind the arc in the game, including 0-of-4 in the second half
 - Have held 12 opponents this season to below 30 percent shooting from behind the arc
- Pitt finished with three total turnovers, tied for the least amount in a game in program history
 - Finished with the highest assist-to-turnover ratio in program history with 7.3:1
 - Recorded 22 assist on 31 made field goals ... fourth time this season with 20+ assists
 - Carlton Carrington (8) and Jaland Lowe (6) combined for 14 assists with just two turnovers
- Had three players score in double figures: Blake Hinson (41), Jaland Lowe (10), and Ishmael Legget (10)
 - The trio combined for 61 of the Panthers 86 points and 13 of the team's 15 made three-pointers
 - Five different Pitt players made a three-pointer

Blake Hinson

- Finished with 41 points ... tied for the third most points in a game in program history
- Reached 1,000 career points on a driving layup with 7:03 remaining in the first half
 - Reached 1,000 points in the fourth fewest games by a player in program history
- Went 9-of-13 from behind the arc
 - nine three-pointers made in a game matched his won school record set earlier this season in a win at West Virginia
- Moved up to fifth all-time in three-point field goals made in a season in program history
 - Became 10th in three-pointers attempted in a season in program history
- 27 of his 41 points were scored in the first half ... tied for the fourth most in a half in program history
- 41 points is the most points scored by a Pitt player ever at the Petersen Events Center
 - 14 field goals made is tied for the most made by a Pitt player at the Petersen Events Center
 - 24 field goal attempts is tied for the most by a Pitt player at the Petersen Events Center
 - 9 three-point field goals made is the most all-time by any player at the Petersen Events Center
- His 41 points on 24 field goal attempts is the third least amount of field goal attempts to reach 40+ points in program history
- The last 40+ point game in conference play by an ACC player was Boston College's Jerome Robinson, scoring 46 on February 6, 2018 against Notre Dame

Ishmael Leggett

- Scored 10 points, with three rebounds and two assists in his tenth straight game coming off the bench
 - Shot 4-of-7 from the field and 2-of-4 from behind the arc
 - Has scored in double figures in seven out of 10 games coming off of the bench

Jaland Lowe

- Scored 10 points, with five assists and four rebounds for his 10th double figure scoring game of the season
 - Shot 2-of-5 from three-point range and 2-of-2 from the foul line
- Has started 11 straight games, scoring in double figures in eight of 11 starts, including two 20+ point games in that span

Carlton Carrington

- Added five points with eight assists and six rebounds
 - Has led team in assists 15 times this season

Federiko Federiko

- Finished with eight points and eight rebounds ... ninth game with seven or more rebounds
 - Has seven or more rebounds in four of the past five games
