Boat Tour

Clear Kayak Adventures

For a more immersive way to experience Florida's natural beauty, [Get Up and Go Kayaking](#) offers clear kayak tours through [Shell Key Preserve](#). Floating above seagrass flats and shallow waters, visitors might spot dolphins, seabirds and seasonal wildlife as they glide past mangrove islands and sandbars. Evening tours elevate the experience further, with sunset paddles that transition into twilight and glow tours that illuminate the water below with LED lights. Launching in Tierra Verde near St. Pete Beach, these guided excursions combine adventure and nature in one unique outing. Get Up and Go Kayaking also offers clear kayak tours across the Anclote River waters in Tarpon Springs and Clearwater Beach.

Island-Hopping

A true island experience is closer than it seems in St. Pete-Clearwater. [Honeymoon Island State Park](#) offers four miles of soft beaches, ideal for swimming and shelling, along with a scenic trail through a virgin pine forest. From there, visitors can reach [Caladesi Island State Park](#) by ferry or kayak, best known for its uncrowded beaches and excellent birdwatching. Farther offshore, [Egmont Key State Park](#) is home to one of the last government-operated lighthouses in the U.S. and rewards those looking for a day trip with nearly deserted beaches and historic ruins.
