LAST NIGHT, THE WHITE HOUSE'S OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET SENT A MEMO TO FEDERAL AGENCIES TELLING THEM TO PREPARE FOR MASS LAYOFFS AHEAD OF A POTENTIAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN NEXT WEEK.
