Equipment Accidents

Some of the major catastrophic accidents that have happened at festivals worldwide have included equipment malfunctions and stage collapses. Fortunately, there haven't been reports of major accidents at the Nashville Oktoberfest so far.

Crowd-related Injuries

Controlling a large crowd can be difficult, especially when people have indulged in alcohol and substance abuse. Often, festivals report fatalities and severe injuries from trampling at the event. It's also common to have cases of assault injuries as large crowds interact. Festival organizers try to maintain security and crowd control, but there could be a few incidents.

Weather-related Accidents

An unexpected gust of wind can turn a tent into a projectile. Such accidents are a harsh

reminder to never underestimate Mother Nature and her unpredictability.

Injuries from Animals

The Dachshund Derby is a crowd favorite at Nashville's Oktoberfest. Thousands of people enjoy watching dogs race and compete in the best-dressed dog category. Take photos and videos and keep all related documentation.
