Our take on the Aura Carver Digital Picture Frame

We love Aura Digital Picture Frames because they're an easy way to display multiple pictures in a limited space. They're also customizable, so you can change the pictures anytime through the Aura application on your phone.

We chose the Carver model because it has a simple landscape design for a fair price (\$149) and comes in two colors: black (gravel) or white (sea salt). You can choose fancier styles, like the 15-inch matted <u>Walden</u> frame, for up to \$299. And if you want to make it more personalized, you can choose the images before gifting.



Gardener's Tool Seat from Uncommon Goods

✓ The Gardener's Tool Seat from Uncommon Goods made our list because it's a practical gift for grandmothers who need a comfortable way to tend to their garden. It sits low enough to reach plants on the ground but high enough to prevent aching joints.

Key features

- Price: \$48
- **Shipping:** \$9 (free for Uncommon Goods members only)
- Returns: Allowed within 30 days of receiving the order
- Seat height: 16.75 inches
- Weight capacity: 250 pounds

If your grandma spends a lot of time in her garden, she might find a gardening seat useful. We like the Gardener's Tool Seat because it has a removable storage tote for tools and folds up easily to move around the yard.

Although it's shorter than an average seat at about 17 inches, it's a welcome trade-off for gardeners who need to reach down low. But if your grandma has trouble standing from chairs without pushing off the sitting surface, she may need a higher seat for safety.

✓ Older adults with mobility issues, like poor balance or weakness, may feel nervous about doing certain activities at home or in their community in case of a fall. Walkers and canes may be a good option to prevent falls, and an on-the-go medical alert system (like the MGMini) can help improve overall safety.

- Standout perks: Unlimited range with caregiver alerts and location tracking

Pros and cons

Our take on the Medical Guardian MGMini

Medical alert systems can help people **prevent falls** and feel safe in their environment in case of emergency, but people often don't find them appealing. We love the MGMini from Medical Guardian because it's one of the smallest <u>on-the-go medical alert systems</u> on the market with unlimited range, so your grandmother can feel safe wherever she goes (as long as Wi-Fi, GPS, or AT&T connection is available). It also comes in four colors, including rose gold, pearl, silver, and black for a more stylish appearance.

Although this could be a great gift, it's worth having a conversation with your grandma about her mobility needs and level of independence before you give it. Also, talk about how it would reassure you if she was open to using a medical alert device such as a pendant. Devices like these have monitoring features, like location tracking and caregiver alerts, which you might want to discuss.

Tinggly Adventure Awaits Box

✓ A Tinggly box is a great gift for adventurous types. When your grandmother receives an Adventure Awaits box, she can book one activity from more than 1,000 options, such as a spa day, outdoor adventure, food experience, or city tour.

Key features

- **Price**: \$69
- **Shipping:** Free eVoucher via email or \$10 for a gift box
- Expiration: None, redeem at any time
- Attendee limit: Up to four people

Pros and cons

Our take on the Tinggly Adventure Awaits box

If your grandmother loves to try new things, the Tinggly Adventure Awaits box could get a good fit. Once your grandmother receives the voucher (via email or an eco-friendly gift box), she can choose one activity from a list of options of similar value. Some options are local, and some are



Tinggly offers many gift boxes, but the Adventure Awaits box is the most budget-friendly at \$69 and provides more than 12,500 activity choices. If you think she'd rather stay local, you can check for options in your grandmother's area on the product's page. You can also shop for other boxes, which range in cost from less than \$100 to more than \$500.

Yeti Rambler 36-Ounce Water Bottle

✓ We love the Yeti Rambler 36-ounce Water Bottle because you can choose between four basic colors and 12 seasonal colors. You can also customize the bottle for your grandma with a specific design or text. And since this bottle has a handle, it's easier to carry it around or twist the top off.

• Price: \$30 without customizations



• Standout perks: Straw cap and carrying handle

Pros and cons

Our take on the Yeti Rambler 36-Ounce Water Bottle

<u>Hydration</u> is important, especially as we age. The Yeti Rambler 36-ounce Water Bottle could be a great tool for your grandma so she can meet the <u>National Academy of Medicine's</u> recommended nine cups per day for adults age 51 and older (unless otherwise directed by a doctor).

This water bottle comes in about 16 colors, depending on the season. We love that you can customize it with your own text and design. For example, you can label the bottle with her name or initials. This will cost about \$6 extra per side (front or back). We also like how it comes with a handle, so it's easier to carry it and twist off the top for refills compared to flat-top tumblers.

LEKI Lhasa Trekking Poles from Backcountry

✓ LEKI Lhasa Trekking poles made our list because their European-made design offers steadiness on trails. This gift is great for people who want extra support walking on uneven terrain, whether hiking with the family or walking a muddy trail at the local park.

Key features

- Price: \$100
- Shipping: Free
- Adjustable length: 35.4–49.2 inches
- Material: Aluminum

Pros and cons

Our take on the LEKI Lhasa Trekking Pole

If your grandmother frequents the local park or walks nearby trails (preferably with a partner for safety), she may appreciate added security and steadiness on uneven ground. We like the LEKI Lhasa Trekking Pole because it's made with lightweight, durable aluminum and contoured grips, making it easy and comfortable to use. It's also adjustable to fit many people—or if they're really into hiking—to trek uphill or downhill at a more comfortable handle height for the terrain.

While trekking poles can be helpful, they are not replacements for walkers or canes. This gift is best for a grandmother who feels confident walking without assistance but could use extra support walking or hiking on uneven terrain.

MasterClass Subscription

✓ MasterClass is a subscription-based platform where people learn about topics ranging from art to cooking via celebrity-led virtual classes. It made our list because anyone of any skill level can learn something new or apply a new technique to a hobby.

- Price: Starts at \$120, billed annually
- Trial period: 30 days
- Shipping: N/A
- Device sharing: One to six, depending on plan
- Device compatibility: Smart TV, mobile device, computer

Pros and cons

Our take on the MasterClass Subscription

No matter your age or skill level, you can always learn something new. We love MasterClass because it offers expert-led lessons designed to teach new skills and introduce you to new



writing, and cooking.

To start, choose a monthly plan (billed annually). The basic plan starts at \$120 per year and provides access to all the classes, but upgrading to the Plus (\$180) or Premium (\$240) plans allows you to download the videos or view them across multiple devices.

✓ Making pasta from scratch can be a fun family activity. The Garrett Wade Italian Pasta Rolling Pins could provide a new way to make different types of pasta, like spaghetti, tagliatelle, and pappardelle.

Our take on the Garrett Wade Italian Pasta Rolling Pins

Grandmothers who love to cook may appreciate an easy way to make batches of pasta. We love the Garrett Wade Italian Pasta Rolling Pins because the set includes four beechwood pins for less than \$40 (plus shipping), which is a good value.

Since these pins make longer pasta, like spaghetti, you can pair this gift with the **Foldable Pasta Drying Rack** for about \$20 more. This allows the pasta strands to dry without tangling up, giving the final product a better texture.

Fleece jackets are warm, cozy, and great for mild fall, spring and <u>winter weather</u>. We like this jacket because of its appealing color choices and fun design, including its two front pockets and half snap-button closure. As of the writing of this review, you can choose between a flower pattern, pink, white, and dark green (plus yellow and orange on sale).

But if your grandma needs an easier closure, like a full zip-up design, consider the \$100 North Face Osito Jacket from Backcountry instead.

We love the Tiny Plants set from the LEGO Botanical Collection because it's simpler for beginners who want to ease into the project. You can focus on building one small plant at a time, which is less intense than larger LEGO projects. And when the set is done, it's an attractive display.

Key features

- Price: About \$50
- Shipping: Free for orders more than \$35, otherwise it's \$5–\$7
- Pieces: 758 total
- Size (height x width x depth, in inches): 6.5 x 4 x 2.5 (largest plant)



Our take on the LEGO Tiny Plants

LEGO offers multiple building sets ranging from easy to advanced. If your grandmother likes puzzles, and you want to give her a creative challenge, you may want to consider the Tiny Plant set. Unlike other LEGO sets, this project has nine separate plants to build and instructions for each one. Some are easier than others, so she can ease her way into the challenge. Although this set has more than 700 total pieces, they're divided by each plant. This is more manageable for beginners than larger sets that create one big item.

We understand some people might need fewer or larger pieces due to dexterity issues. LEGO offers other stylish builds for beginners, like the **Sunflower** or **Chrysanthemum** projects.

Our take on the June & December Field Flower Press

The June & December Field Flower Press is different from other flower presses because it's lightweight and uses heavy bands to apply pressure. The bands might be tricky to wrap around the press since they're designed to be tight, but other presses use nuts and bolts to apply pressure, making them bulkier and less portable. This flower press is the better choice if you can see your grandma taking it along as she walks, hikes, or travels.

William Morris' artwork has fine details, but some people may want larger coloring blocks to enjoy the activity. If your grandmother has trouble with fine movements in her fingers and hands, she may enjoy coloring books inspired by **Charley Harper** or **William H. Johnson** instead.

If she doesn't like it, she can swap it for another choice. This gift is a good way to keep her book selection fresh, exciting, and to her liking.

Ventilation points allow airflow, and drainage holes prevent waterlogging. It also has a large access point, making cleaning the house once or twice a year easy. Although we love the She Shed design, you may also want to consider other options, like the <u>White Veranda</u> or <u>Stone</u> Cottage houses.

How to choose a gift for grandma

If you enjoyed our list but didn't find the right option, consider using these three points to brainstorm similar gifts.

Pricing

Gifts in our list start around \$10 and can range up to \$200 or more for subscription-based items.

If you're shopping on a budget, less expensive items can include art supplies or smaller everyday items. A small momento, like a hand-written card and printed pictures recapping your favorite memories, doesn't cost much and can mean a lot. If you're interested in a larger or more customized gift, you might consider splitting the cost with other family members.

Engagement

Practical, engaging gifts can spark joy every time your grandma uses them. Some usable gifts also encourage creativity and may introduce a new hobby. These are the "gifts that keep on giving," always reminding your grandma of the day she received them.

Personality

The gift should match your grandmother's personality and ability. Someone who hates tea shouldn't get a tea subscription, but someone who loves gardening may need new planters.



Bottom line

The best gifts for your grandmother are personal, engaging, and spark joy with frequent use. Our list was carefully crafted to include unique ideas your grandmother may enjoy often. Always consider her personality and ability level before purchasing to make sure it's appropriate and specific to her.
