

A National THC Transparency Bill Should Include...

- A ban on kid-friendly products and flavorings
- Packaging and safety disclosures
- Require:
 - Child-resistant packaging
 - THC Warning Symbol
 - Limits on serving size (potency and weight) and amount per package or container
 - Health and safety disclosures on packaging and advertising
 - Restrictions on advertising and marketing that reaches kids
 - Monitoring and reporting of false claims
- High-priority data collection on physical and mental health impacts of THC on the developing brain



And these protections are needed because...

- The SAFE Banking Act will turbocharge marijuana commercialization before sound product, potency, and policy determinations are made.
- It is vital that before Congress considers giving expansive access to the nation's lucrative financial markets, basic protections for young people are put in place.
- A requirement for basic youth safeguards and sufficient product transparency and accountability needs to be a part of SAFE Banking or any major marijuana legislation.
