Classic browns

A classic, large room divider like this one is perfect for those with simple taste. It's moveable, which means you can adjust it to suit the width of your room as well as the space you need on a particular day. The grilled windows help make it look lighter and less like a heavy door in the middle of your room.

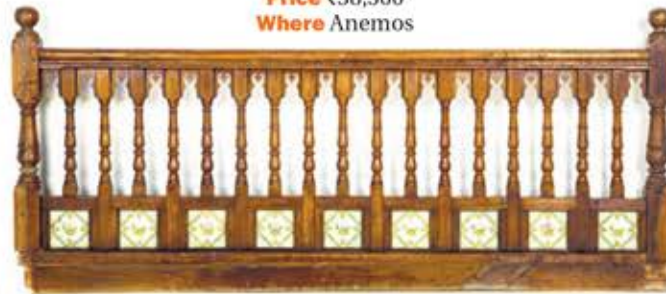
