How to Crochet a Magic Ring

Crocheting magic rings can seem intimidating, but they can be quite simple to create. There are a variety of methods to create a magic ring. This is one of the simpler methods.

What You Need: crochet hook (any sized), yarn (any type)



1. Lay a strand of yarn against your first two fingers.

2.



3. With your thumb, pinch the yarn against your middle finger.



4. Wrap the yarn around your two fingers to form an "X" formation. Make sure that the yarn forms parallel lines on the back of your fingers.





5. Insert your hook below the two yarn strands.



6. Pull the furthest strand under the first strand, twist your hook to form a loop. You will now have a circle and a chain stitch.







7. Go back under again and pull the yarn through the loop to make a single crochet stitch.



8. Start crocheting singles through the loop.



9. After you've made the number of single crochets you want, pull the string to bring them all together in a circle.



10. And now you have the magic circle!
