How to Add a Keychain to Amigurumi



There are several ways to add a keychain to your crochet amigurumi. This is just one of the simple methods that you can use.


What You Need: an amigurumi, yarn (any type), scissors, sewing needle, keychain.



1. Cut a string of yarn 5-12 inches long.



2. Take a thread of yarn and thread it through the sewing needle.



3. Insert the needle inside the amigurumi and exit the sewing needle adjacent to where you want to add the keychain and exit from the stitch adjacent from that point.



4. Go through with that sewing needle at the end of the keychain and into the stitch on the opposite side of where your last exit stitch was.



5. Sew and exit from the same stitches again and repeat the process until you feel comfortable that the yarn is secured enough.



6. For the final round, exit where the tail end of the yarn is and cut the yarn.



7. Tie the two strands together tightly.



8. Cut the strands close and hide the ends inside the amigurumi





9. Attachment is now complete!
