PNMs

Current Members

PNMs

Believing or spreading negative stereotypes about sororities.

Believe that a chapter or its members can “promise” you a spot in the chapter.

What is *Dirty Rushing*?



A sorority member will attempt to influence a PNM through social media interactions, talking poorly about other chapters, promising a bid in their chapter, etc.



Guaranteeing that you will get invited back to another round of recruitment. Using language such as “see you tomorrow” or anything can mislead the PNM to believe they are promised an invitation to the next round.



Inviting PNMs to underground recruitment events or pre-games.



Chapter members telling PNMs to withdraw because they will have a better chance at a spot after recruitment.
