

Alexandria's Historic Charm

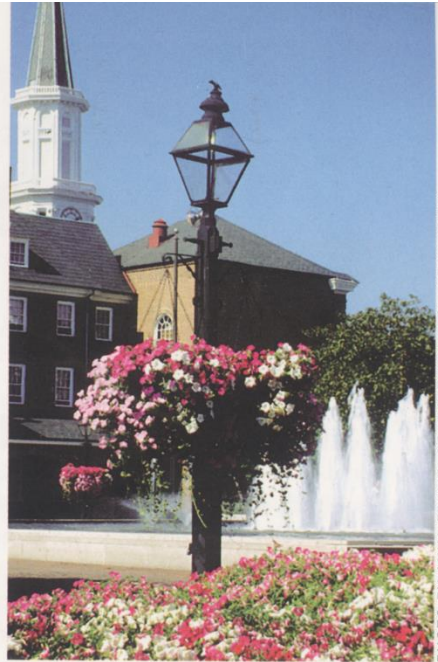
