- Pools and spas have minimum-age and unattended-age restrictions. For the benefit of *all* owners, please abide by them. There is no lifeguard on duty.
 - Little children naturally love to play in the water, which is a delight to see. They also naturally do other things in the water that are less delightful. For this reason, please make sure your diaper-age children are wearing leak-proof protective pants when they visit WorldMark pools.
 - Glass bottles and radios should not be brought into the pool and spa areas.
 - Don't cannonball into the pools, don't jump or dive into the spas, and remember that running on pool decks can cause serious injury.
