The wireless devices that run your software must be AT&T certified also. If the device does not appear in the AT&T Certified Device List, you can contact the manufacturer about certification. The device manufacturer must complete device certification before you request certification for your software.





The Software Certification Process

Follow these five steps to gain AT&T Enterprise Software Certification for your solution:



Join devCentral.

Become a member of devCentral, the AT&T developer program. Joining devCentral gives you access to certification programs, wireless enterprise infrastructure documentation, developer gateways, developer forums, and support. The standard-level membership is free.

Request certification.

Submit an online certification request through the devCentral Web site. You can submit a request right away, or open a request now and submit it later.

Plan the tests.

After accepting your certification request, AT&T will set up a meeting to review technical details and schedule the tests.

Provide an engineering contact.

During the testing period, an engineering contact from your company must be available by telephone to provide technical assistance with any challenges that the testers encounter.



Activate your benefits.

When your solution passes testing, you will receive an AT&T Solution Certification Program Agreement. Execute this agreement to receive access to the AT&T Certified Solution logo and other benefits.
