#### What is the cheapest way to get internet at home?

Access from AT&T is a low cost home internet service available to eligible limited income AT&T Internet and AT&T Fiber households who participate in Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for California residents, National School Lunch Program, or with a household income below 200% of federal poverty guidelines. Speeds on AT&T Internet depend on the maximum speed available at your location. The \$30/mo. Access from AT&T plan available with internet speed plans up to 75 Mbps to 100 Mbps comes with unlimited monthly data. Eligible households whose maximum available speed available at their home is 10 Mbps or less and who don't need unlimited monthly data may qualify for a lower-priced offer. A Wi-Fi® gateway/modem and installation are included with all Access from AT&T plans at no charge.

Eligible AT&T DSL customers can also qualify for the lower-priced Access from AT&T offer. AT&T fixed wireless internet and other wireless services are not eligible for Access from AT&T.

#### What is an AT&T reward card?

Member FDIC, pursuant to a license from Visa U.S.A Inc. and can be used everywhere Visa debit cards are accepted in the United States, District of Columbia, U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico.

If you qualify to receive an AT&T reward card, you will be sent an email or letter with redemption requirements within six weeks of activation of qualifying service. Redemption is required within 75 days from reward notification email or mail date. Then, your reward card will be delivered within three to four weeks provided you maintain and pay for qualifying service from activation date through fulfillment. Learn more about AT&T reward cards






