Why we're here



A child born in Cambodia is five times more likely to die before their fifth birthday than a child born in a wealthy country



74% of Cambodians live in rural areas



One in five Cambodians survive on less than US\$2.70 a day



Children from the poorest families are three times more likely to die early than children from wealthier families



During the Khmer Rouge, Cambodia lost an entire generation of health workers. Only 25 doctors survived



Leading causes of death are complications at birth, pneumonia, birth defects, diarrhoea and malaria — all preventable or treatable

Kosal was just four months old when he got very sick. He couldn't eat without vomiting, rapidly lost weight and started fainting. His mother Leaphy was terrified.

Kosal had an intestinal infection called gastroenteritis. Within two weeks, his condition became critical when his bowel perforated — a life-threatening medical emergency.

"I felt so hopeless as his condition worsened. I prepared myself for the worst — I didn't think he'd make it."

Kosal's condition was dire. He stayed in our intensive care unit for the next three months while our staff worked tirelessly to help him.

After three surgeries and three months of intensive support, Kosal finally got better. Today, he's growing into a strong and healthy boy.

11-month-old Minea arrived at AHC with a nosebleed and high fever. Tests showed she had severe dengue fever, which led to sepsis — a life-threatening complication of the infection.

"My daughter had never been so ill. We cried and begged the doctors and nurses to help," recalled Raksa, Minea's mother. "I have no money. I was worried about her health but also the cost."

But with antibiotics, intravenous and roundthe-clock monitoring, Minea's condition quickly improved. After four days in intensive care, Minea transferred to our in-patient department.



During her 22 days at AHC, Minea received constant care by our doctors and nurses. Our nutrition team also handled her post-recovery diet, and our medical social work team took care of all her medical costs.

"If not for everyone at AHC, my daughter might've died. We received the best care, and it was free. AHC saved my daughter — I'll never forget it."
