

WWE star JD McDonagh suffers a scary injury during tag team championship match on Raw



Irish wrestler JD McDonagh has updated WWE fans in a post on X that he has suffered a couple of broken ribs and a punctured lung during his tag team championship against the War Raiders on Monday Night Raw.

McDonagh teamed with fellow Judgement Day member Dominik Mysterio in an effort to win back the World Tag Team Championships but suffered the devastating injury when his back viciously bounced off of the commentary desk whilst performing a springboard moonsault on fellow wrestler Ivar.

Despite being in pain, the 34 year old valiantly finished the match in a losing effort in front of 12,000 fans in Atlanta's All State Arena but concern for the Irish Ace grew after an image of him collapsing near the entrance stage circulated online.

McDonagh was immediately sent to hospital following his match and he later provided fans with an update on his condition on social media app X, formerly known as twitter.

“First off, thanks to everyone for the messages and the concern. I'm good.

I've got a couple of broken ribs and a punctured lung, so I'm going to be out for a couple months. All things considered, it could have been a lot worse, so I'm grateful for that.

See ya in a bit. 🙌”

Fans are thankfully surprised that McDonagh did not suffer any damage to his neck and head as originally speculated.

McDonagh has been associated with the WWE since 2016 but it was not until 2023 that the former cruiserweight champion joined the roster of WWE's flagship show Raw where he was recruited by real life mentor Finn Balor to be a member of the popular Judgement Day faction.

It is unclear the direction the faction goes without McDonagh being present as rivalries with Rhea Ripley, Damian Priest and the War Raiders have been concluded over the past few weeks.
