The Master 300 & 400 gained flagship status as the best-known and revered Strombergs.

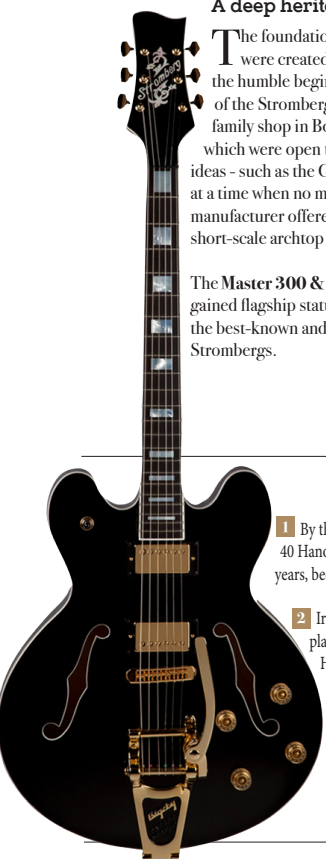
New era For Stromberg

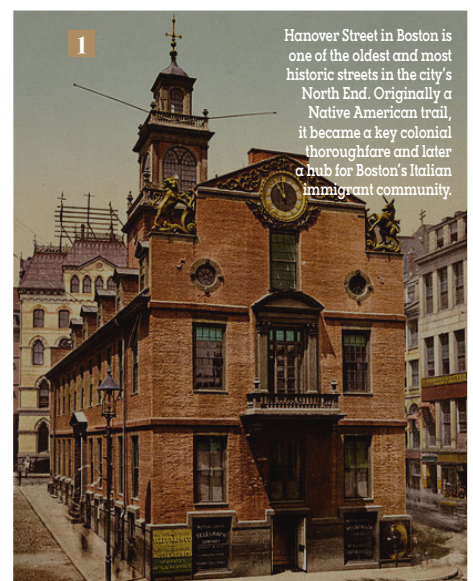

The Elegant Montreux Trans-Amber Aged Cutaway

With a classic design, this full hollow body showcases a maple back, sides, and flamed maple top. This 16,5" jazz box features a traditional Stromberg tailpiece, pearloid pickguard, Free Floating Jazz humbucker in the neck position and a wooden bridge with piezo pickup. The maple neck

has an ebony fretboard with mother-of-pearl block inlay, vintage white binding and a pointed end, reminiscent of various Gibson models. Designed for rich, resonant tones, it delivers the warm, articulate sound ideal for jazz musicians.
