Friends of the Clinton River Trail is a volunteer driven, nonprofit organization committed to promoting the Clinton River Trail as a safe and enjoyable destination. They work closely with the five cities that own the trail on its maintenance, development, and beautification. Currently, they are working hard to restore one of our community's most treasured trails. In July 2024, torrential rains caused a catastrophic washout near Mile Marker 1/2, creating a 100 foot long, 12 foot deep gap that disrupted trail access and impacted the nearby heron rookery.




## Neighborhood House
