

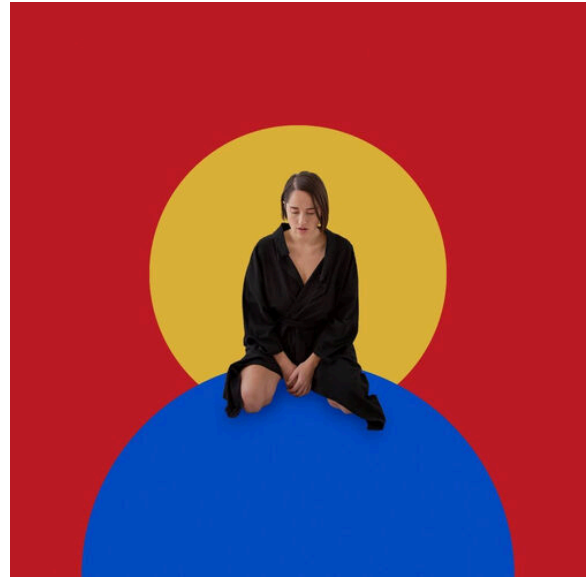
Artist Spotlight:
