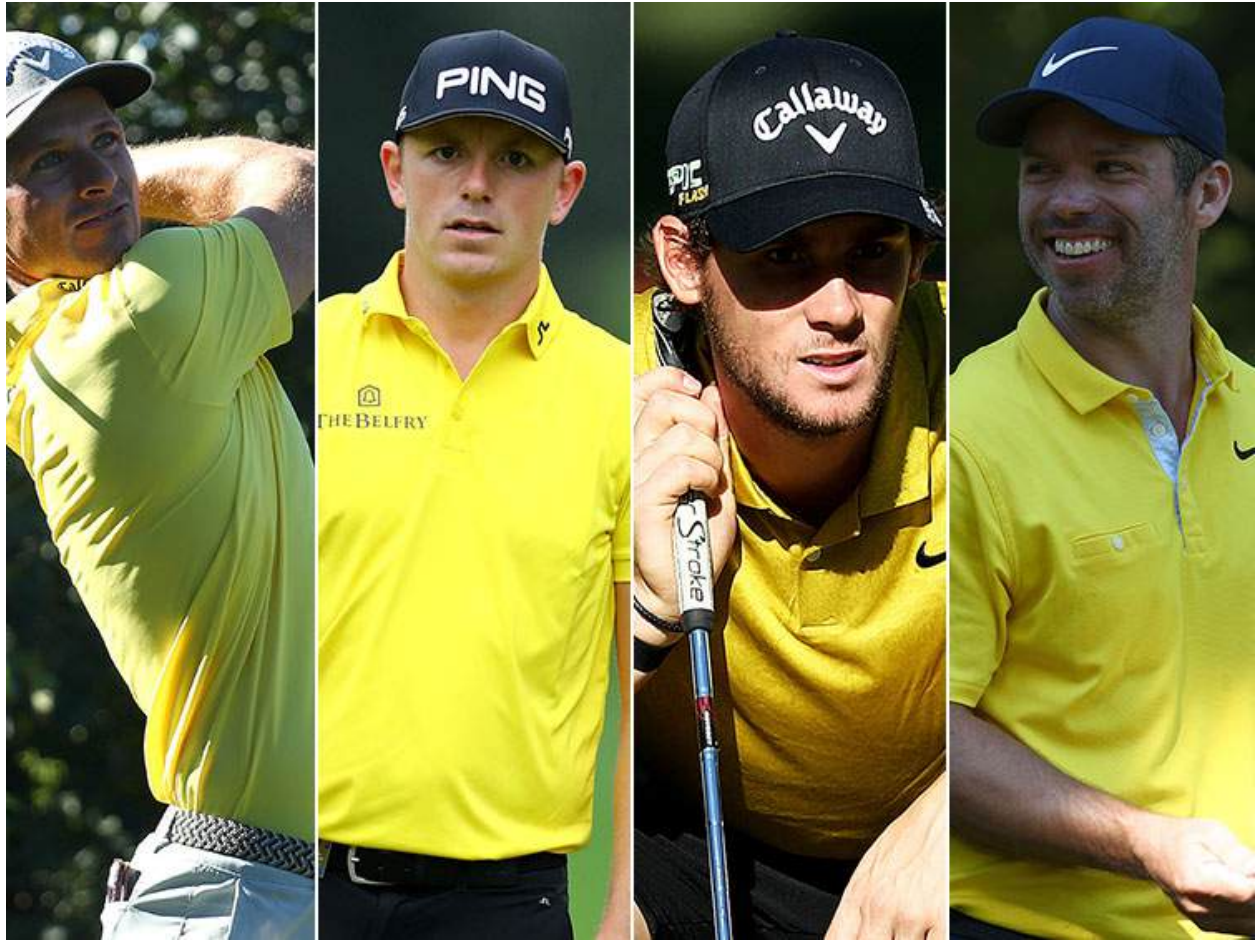


Fashion Roundup: Week of Oct. 7-13
