- Information on community resources and other forms of assistance

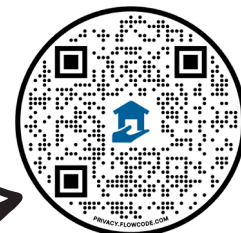

We serve all Fort Bend county veterans who have previously served in all branches of the United States military. To be eligible for our services, you must provide:

- DD214
- Proof of residency
- Proof of housing instability (vacate or eviction notice)
- Proof of income
