In 1935, our grandfather Papa Rozier bought his first piece of land.

On a fertile plot nestled in the mountains of southwest Haiti, he grew corn, rice, millet and plantain. He raised cows, goats, pigs, and chickens and was fruitful farmer. He slowly acquired more and more farmland, until, by his passing in 1985, he owned 50-acres. He didn't have a formal education, but he knew he was building something to leave behind, a legacy that would outlive him.

For over a decade now, we have been building on this legacy, with our farm retailer Papa Rozier Farms.

At Papa Rozier Farms our hands touch every part of the process: on our grandfather's land, we grow and harvest our own organic moringa and castor seeds; then, we ship them to our Farmhouse in Brooklyn. Here, we cold-press, clean, and bottle our 100% moringa and castor oils. Then comes the best part: getting them into the hands of our customers, who use our oils to #staybeautifulnaturally.

For over 10 years we've been perfecting our products and, because we handle every, single part of the process, from farm to retail, we can promise you a few things:

- Integrity: we are farmers *and* retailers and we don't cut corners anywhere. This means that the quality of oils you buy is truly unmatched
- Purity: unlike other companies, we sun-dry and hand-pick the best organic seeds to use in our products, which means that what you get is pure, undiluted castor or moringa oil plain and simple
