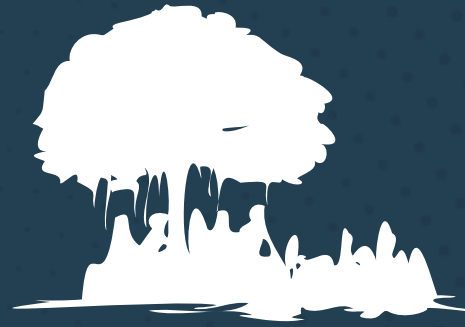

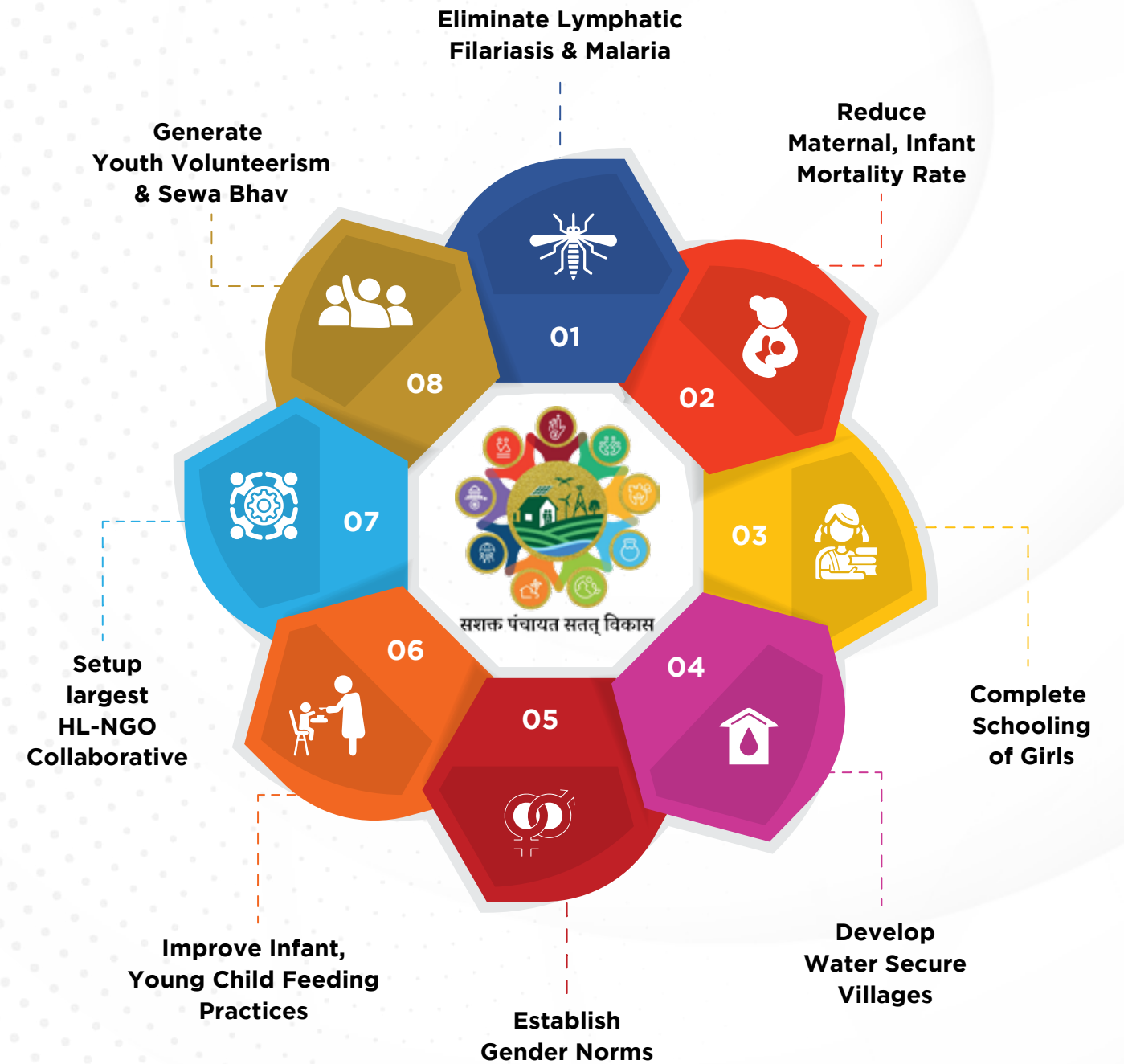

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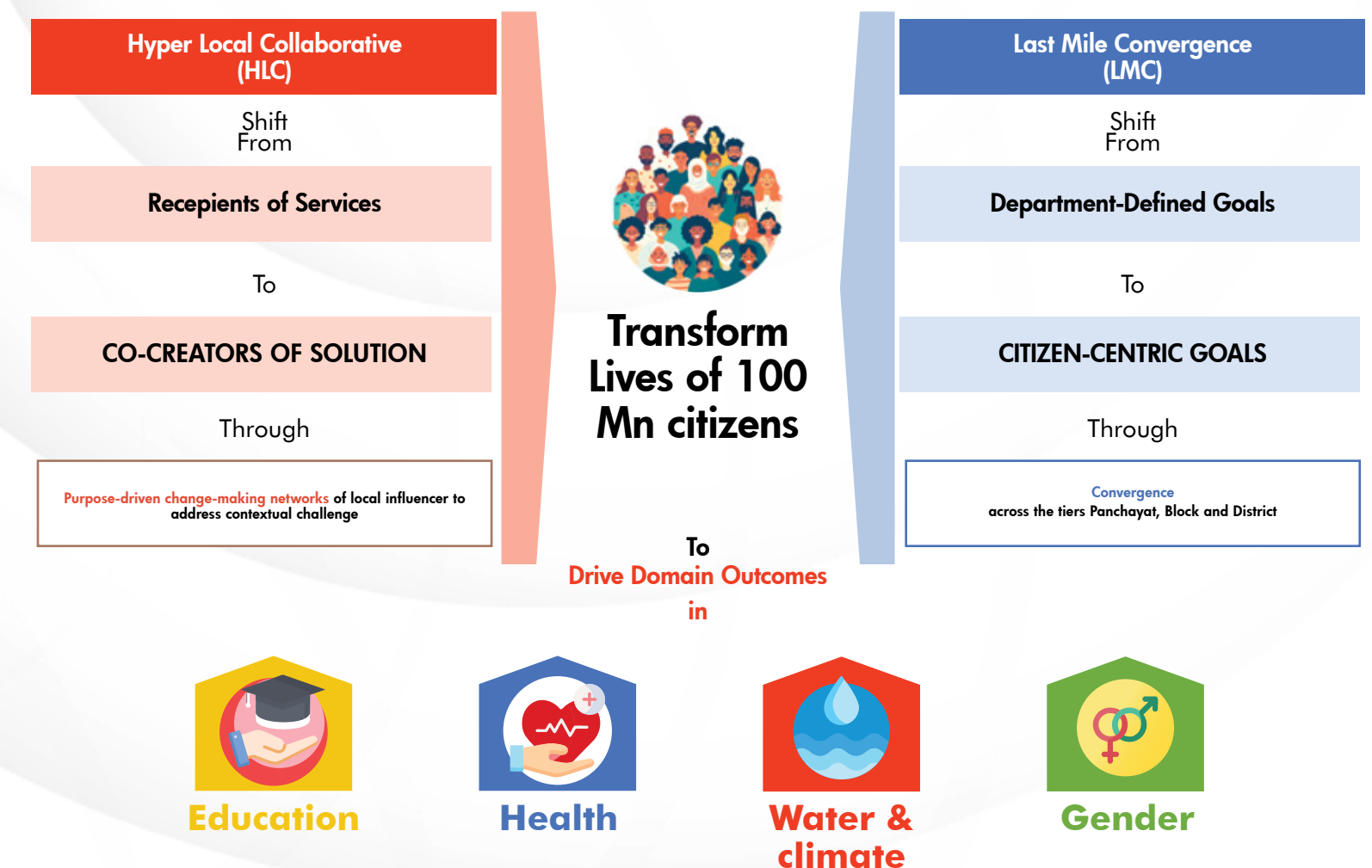

Kamalghati, Pakur, Jharkhand, Sarpanch is driving education outcomes by conducting student assessments and regularizing SMCs., and leading efforts in panchayat meeting for libraries Through a **Child Friendly GPDP**, community as a whole is working towards community-driven Child friendly initiatives.



Madhya Pradesh



In Vidhisha MP, Sarpanches and ward members led an initiative to support out-of-school girls by mapping households and organizing scholarship camps. With help from local youth, NGOs, and faith leaders, elected panchayat leaders ensured girls stayed in schools. Their efforts resulted in **4,000** girls returning to school, **60,000** receiving scholarships, and 500+ Sarpanches conducting document correction camps to drive enrollment.



Bihar

In Ultibara panchayat Gaya, Bihar, regular meetings between the Sarpanch and school children have improved coordination between schools and Panchayats. The Sarpanch also organizes Bal Sabhas, providing a platform for community members to listen to children's voices. This initiative aims to enhance the quality of education by incorporating children's feedback into local decision-making.

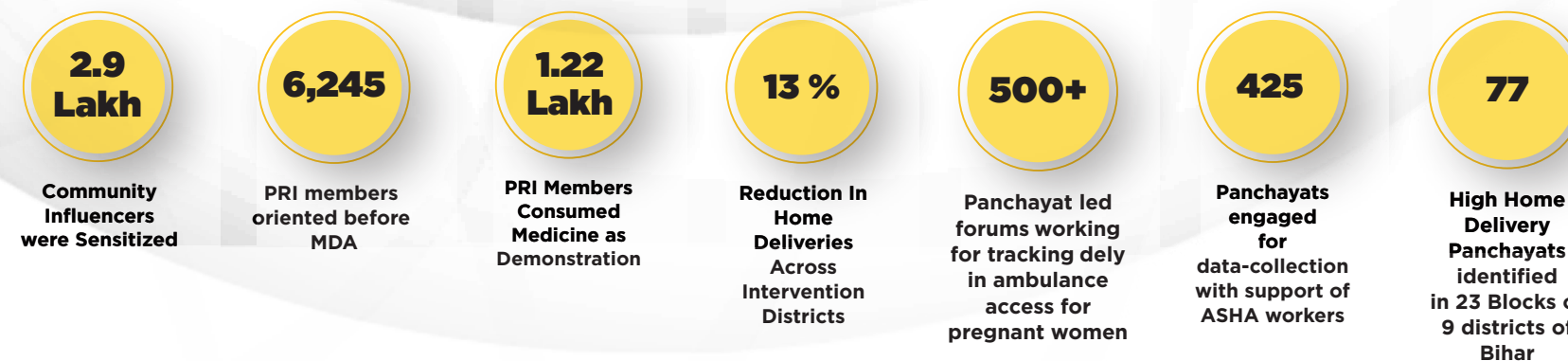




Panchayat led Health – Empowering Panchayats to lead Health transformation

By leveraging local governance structures, they can facilitate community-based solutions for preventive and primary healthcare. Strengthening their capacity can enhance participatory planning, last-mile convergence, and behaviour change communication. A hyperlocal, leadership-driven approach can transform rural healthcare outcomes.

Strengthening panchayat-led institutional delivery initiatives by enhancing availability, accessibility, quality and affordability of maternal healthcare services through last-mile convergence and hyper-local collaboration.



Jharkhand



In Majhgaon, Gumla, Jharkhand, a tribal women Sarpanch led a Gram Sabha prioritized 'Healthy Panchayat' LSDG, focusing on anaemia. Panchayat collaborated with Health, and ICDS staff to celebrate Annaprashan Day. The initiative engaged health workers, PRI members, and caregivers to promote better health practices in the community.



Building 'Lymphatic Filariasis (LF) Mukt' Panchayats



Bihar



Shifting from individual Sarpanch/Mukhiya engagement to a community-driven approach, actively supported by State Governments and PRIs, to enhance MDA drug uptake with the involvement of elected representatives.



In Muradpur, Sitamarhi, Bihar, Sarpanch and PRI members led by example by publicly consuming MDA tablets to combat hesitation against Lymphatic Filariasis (LF). This initiative helped address fears and encouraged community participation in the LF eradication drive. The panchayat leadership was instrumental in promoting health awareness, ensuring widespread participation, and making their **Panchayat LF Mukt**.

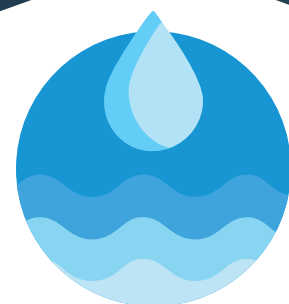

Water Sustainability Practices



Lachras Panchayat in Nandod block, **Narmada, Gujarat** home to 4,000 tribal residents across eight villages, faced a severe water crisis due to over-extraction, insufficient rainfall, and contamination. Recognizing the importance of community-driven water security, the panchayat initiated a women-led Paani Samiti, empowering citizens to manage water resources. This collective effort not only addressed the crisis but also led to the group winning a state government award of INR 50,000.



The District Panchayat Dashla of **Dahod, Gujarat**, recognized the need to enhance the efficiency of its piped water supply schemes and invited support from the Piramal Foundation and UNICEF for training water operators from all panchayats. The training program focused on introducing robust processes for the operation and maintenance of water supply systems. It equipped operators with a clear understanding of roles, responsibilities and mitigation strategies for long-term sustainability of water supply management in the region.





Building Bharat through Decentralization by Last Mile Convergence and Hyperlocal Collaboration led by Youth and Women by Demonstrating in 5,000 Panchayat across Aspirational Districts



Gram Panchayat: The Last-Mile Government

The Gram Panchayat serves as the last-mile government in rural India, embodying the principles of direct democracy. At its core, the **Gram Sabha**—comprising all citizens above 18 years of age—acts as the supreme decision-making body, ensuring participatory planning and governance.

To enhance socio-economic conditions, Gram Panchayats are mandated to formulate an **Annual Development Plan (GPDP - Gram Panchayat Development Plan)** through an inclusive consultative process involving all sections of society. This plan outlines key priorities, from infrastructure development to social welfare initiatives.

The process typically starts on **2nd Oct** every year on birth Mahatma Gandhi and ends on **26th January** every year.



To improve planning process of **2025-26** and achieve key **LSDG** goals 3 special gram sabha along with one national teachers' day event planned in partnership with **MoPR**.

1. **5th September 2024- Building Community Trust**
2. **2nd October 2024- Start Annual Plan Preparation and Need Based Theme Selection**
3. **26th November 2024 - Janjatiya Gurav Diwas- Community Orientation and Training**
4. **26th Jan 2025- Finalizing Annual Plan with Community's Ownership**

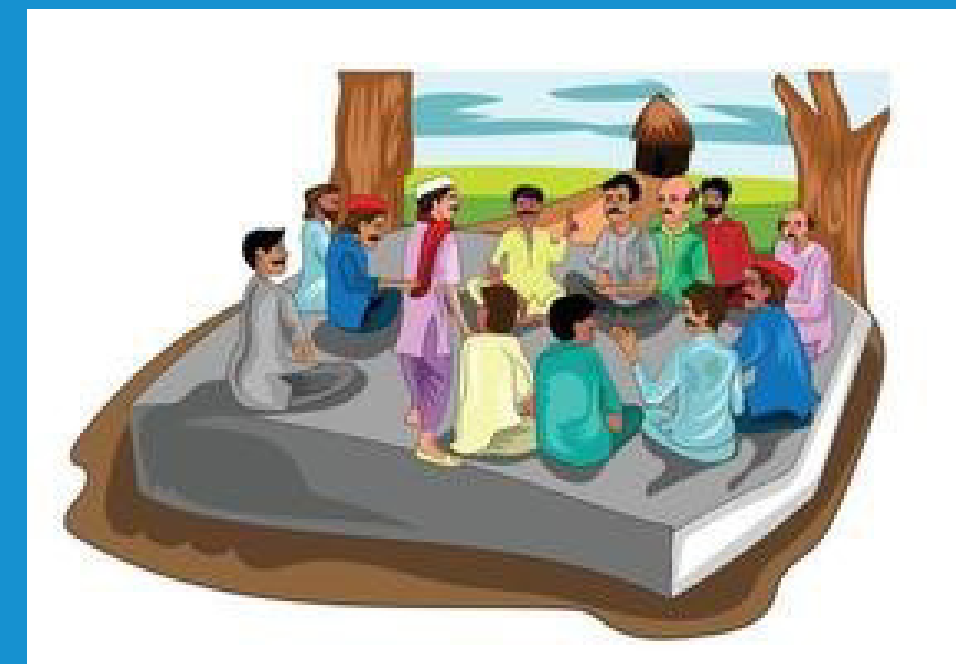
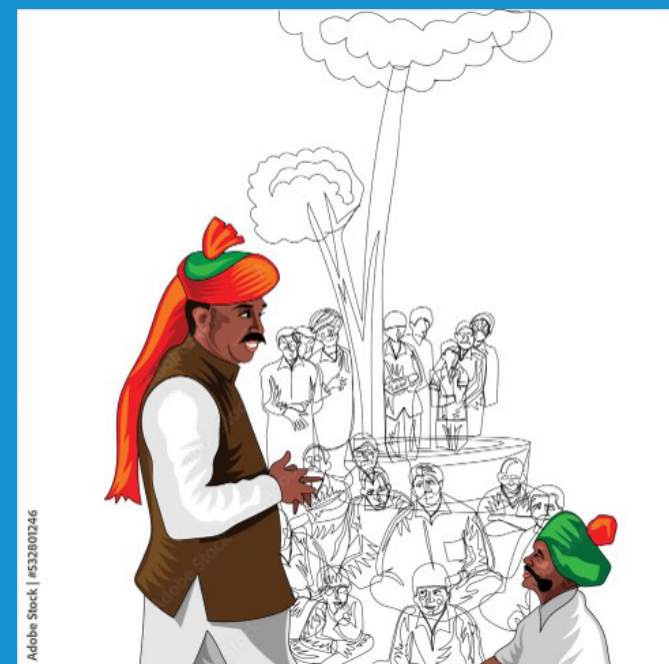

कैवल्य एजुकेशन फाउंडेशन और आईसीडीएस विभाग के समन्वयन से आगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ता की एक दिवसीय कार्यशाला संपन्न हुई

नूड (शोकसेन कोटला) 12 सितंबर : कैवल्य एजुकेशन फाउंडेशन द्वारा टाटा फाउंडेशन लिमिटेड के सहयोग से संचालित एन्यू य आकांक्षी जिला कार्यक्रम नूड के आकांक्षी ब्लॉक पुनर्वास में ग्रामीण स्वास्थ्य, स्वच्छता, और पोषण दिवस (वीएफएसएनडी) तथा शांति एवं शिक्षा पर आगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ताओं के लिए एक दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम में पुनर्वास ब्लॉक की महिला पर्यवेक्षक अलका जी और उषा राणी, तथा मांडिल (वीएफएसएनडी) आगनवाड़ी कार्यशाला का सुधारण आगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ताओं और गांधी फेलो के द्वारा चेचना गैंग और बालगैंग से किया गया। इसके बाद, कैवल्य एजुकेशन फाउंडेशन के प्रोग्राम मैनेजर रिवाज जी ने कार्यशाला का संदर्भ देते हुए फाउंडेशन के बारे में जानकारी दी और कहा कि हमारा उद्देश्य मेवात को विकास की दिशा में आगे ले जाना है। गांधी फेलो सावन कुमार ने प्रारंभिक मातामता देखभाल और शिक्षा (एडए) की अवधारणा और उसके महत्व को समझाया, यह बताते हुए कि बच्चों की 0 से 8

साल की उम्र बहुत महत्वपूर्ण होती है। इस दौरान बच्चे बहुत कुछ सीखते हैं। सामाजिक विकास, मानसिक विकास, शारीरिक विकास और भावनात्मक विकास को सही दिशा देकर बच्चों को भविष्य की निखारने का कार्य करते हैं। इस अवधि में बच्चों की संज्ञात्मक विकास के विभिन्न चरणों को उदाहरण के द्वारा समझाया गया। इसके बाद, कैवल्य एजुकेशन फाउंडेशन के हेल्थ प्रोग्राम के सीनियर प्रोग्राम लीडर मनोज मेहरा ने (वीएफएसएनडी) के महत्व और आगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ताओं, आशा और एएनएम (ट्रिपल ए) की अवधारणा को महत्वपूर्णता पर ध्यान की। उन्होंने कुपोषित और अतिकुपोषित बच्चों की पहचान करने के तरीके, ग्रेज बार्ट द्वारा बच्चों का गणना, और वृद्धि निगरानी के सही तरीके विस्तार से समझाए। इसके साथ ही आईसीडीएस के छह सूचकों

पर भी बच्चों की गई गांधी फेलो अर्जुनी ने आगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ताओं को बच्चों के प्रति जिम्मेदारियों को बताया, और गांधी फेलो पलक भारद्वाज ने सामाजिक, भावनात्मक, नैतिक और शिक्षा की अवधारणा को समूह गतिविधियों के माध्यम से समझाया। बच्चों के मनोभाव को कैसे समझ सकते हैं जिससे की उनके भावनात्मक विकास कर सकते हैं। पुनर्वास ब्लॉक के सीनियर प्रोग्राम लीडर चंदन वर्मा ने पुनर्वास ब्लॉक को आकांक्षी होने के कारणों का उल्लेख किया और शिक्षा तथा स्वास्थ्य में सुधार की आवश्यकता को बताया। उन्होंने शिक्षाओं के भावनात्मक और सामाजिक विकास के प्रभाव पर भी ध्यान की, साथ ही राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 पर विस्तार से बताया। कार्यशाला के अंत में, आगनवाड़ी कार्यकर्ताओं को स्वास्थ्य और शिक्षा में जागरूकता देने के लिए

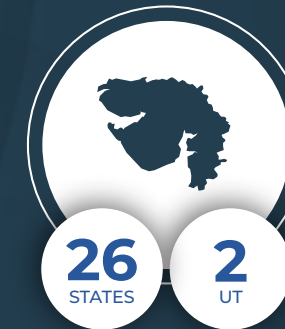

2. As per the timeline, the process of preparation of PDP 2024-25 will start with the Gram Sabha on 2nd October across the country. However, the Ministry has conceptualised to organise special **Gram Sabha cum-orientation/training programme in 750 Gram Panchayats on 2nd October, 2024**, wherein the Senior Citizens above 75 years of age of GP will be sharing their experiences and will be felicitated.

3. Those Gram Panchayats have been selected where the **Young Fellows of the Ministry, Fellows of TRIF and of Piramal Foundation are working and they will act as facilitators** for such Gram Sabha cum- orientation/ training programme. The officials of the Ministry will also be visiting these GPs to oversee the said Gram Sabha cum- orientation/ training programme. The list of these officials will be communicated separately **A concept note, detailed structure of the Programme and list of GPs is annexed.**

4. The expenditure for organising special Gram Sabha cum-orientation/ training programme up to Rs.1 lakh (100 participants @ Rs.1000/- as per the cost norms of Block level training) may be booked under the Capacity Building & Training component of RGSA. The amount to be provided to the identified GPs for successful organisation of the said special Gram Sabha, as per the prescribed structure.

5. I, therefore, shall be grateful for your personal intervention in issuing necessary direction for organizing the proposed program and releasing requisite funds to the aforesaid Gram Panchayats as mentioned in para 4 above, to organize special Gram Sabha cum- orientation/ training programme and also to facilitate and provide other necessary support to organize the program successfully.

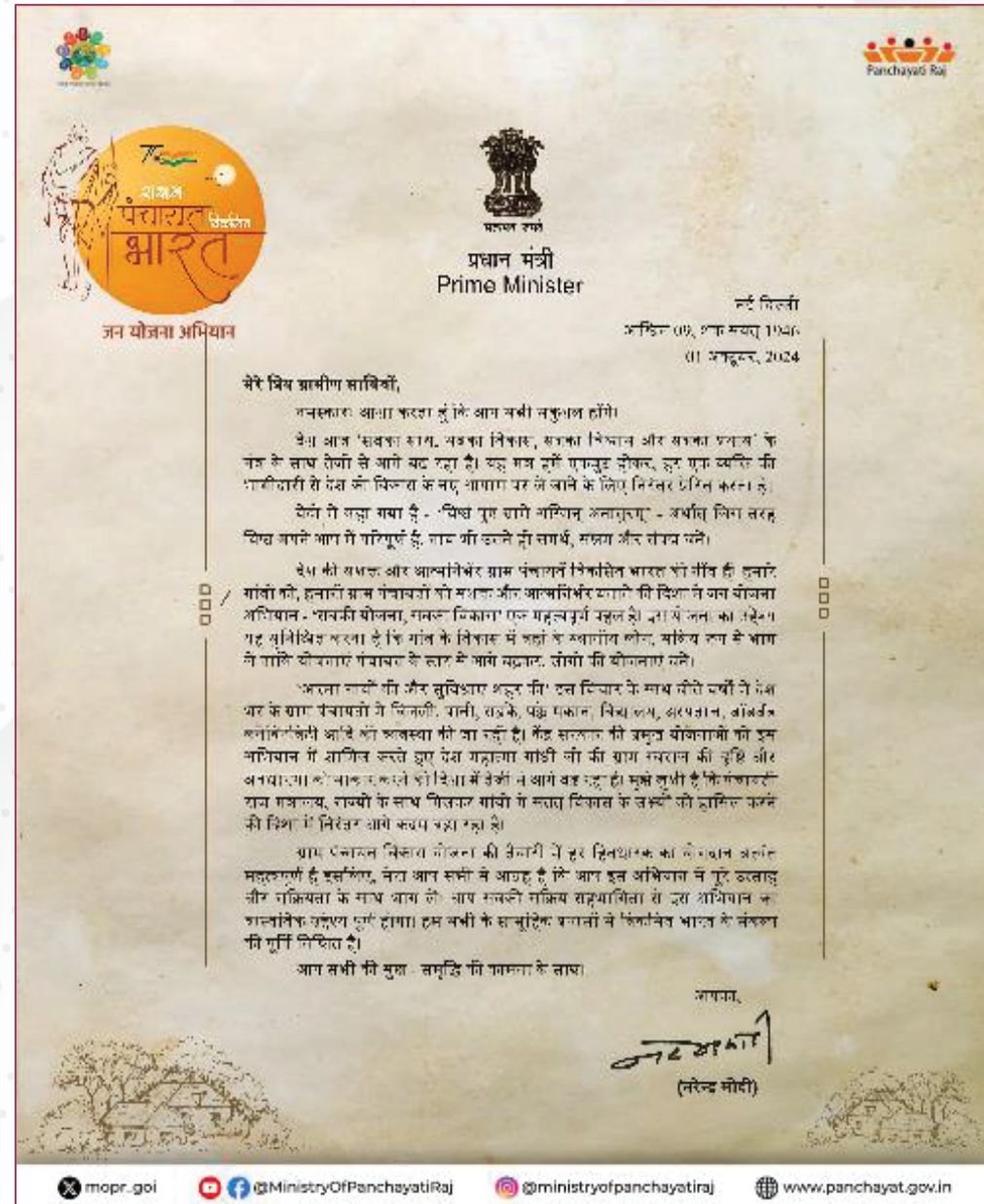

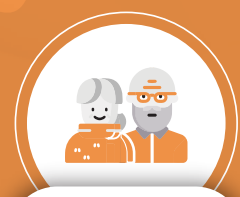

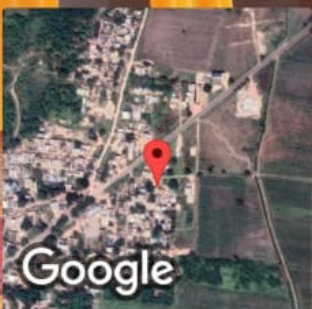

Community Training Gram Sabha, Jan Jatiya Gurav Diwas

Brief

The Janjatiya Abhiyan Gram Sabhas, celebrated on November 15, 2024, marked the 150th birth anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda. This initiative was crucial in empowering tribal communities and residents of PESA areas by enhancing their awareness of key governance frameworks, including the Forest Rights Act (FRA), Panchayats (Extension to the Scheduled Areas) Act (PESA), and the Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP).

Given their strong dependence on forests, traditional governance systems, and community resources, tribal communities needed to understand their legal rights and entitlements to ensure self-reliant and participatory governance. The Sabhas reinforced the role of Gram Sabhas as the primary decision-making bodies in PESA areas, enabling tribal communities to exercise control over their land, water, and forests while ensuring their voices were heard in local governance.

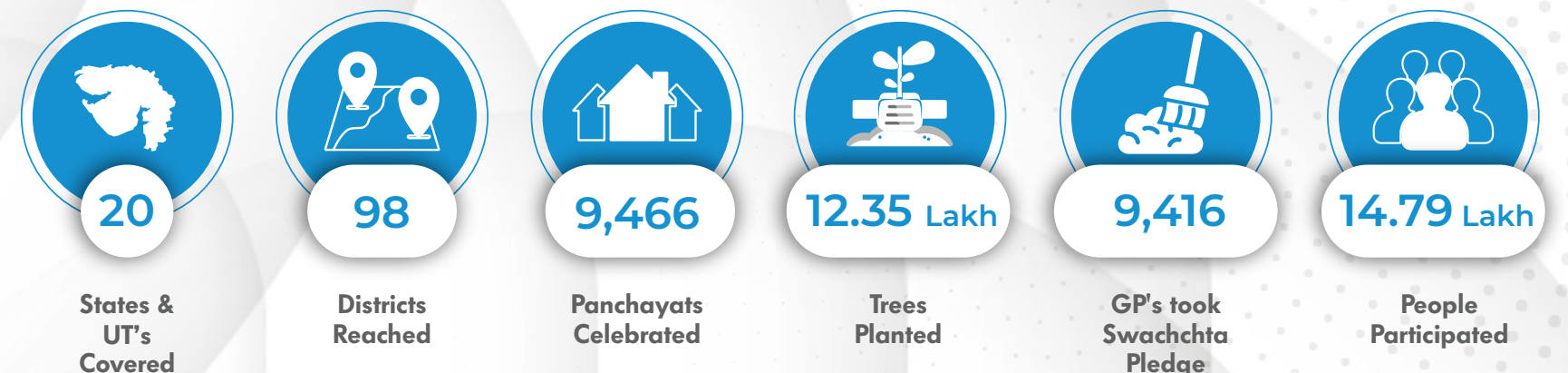
The Gram Sabhas emphasized community engagement and problem-solving through participatory planning. Citizens received training to identify village-level challenges—such as substance abuse, school dropouts, and public health issues—and develop collective solutions through Jan Bhagidari (people's participation). The initiative particularly focused on transforming villages by making them tobacco-free, alcohol-free, school dropout-free, and free from Leprosy & Filariasis (LF) through localized action.

These Gram Sabhas empowered tribal communities/PVTGs to take ownership of their development by helping them leverage government schemes, access rights under FRA and PESA, and advocate for improved public services. The initiative strengthened self-governance, social accountability, and inclusive development, thereby reinforcing Gram Swaraj (self-rule) and ensuring that tribal communities' traditional wisdom and aspirations remained central to local governance.

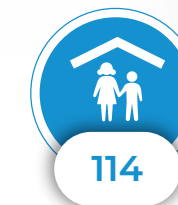
