Student Use of Lexia PowerUp Literacy

1. Purpose

To guide students on how to properly access, use, and engage with the Lexia PowerUp Literacy program for the purpose of improving literacy skills.

2. Scope

This SOP applies to all students required to use Lexia PowerUp Literacy as part of their reading or intervention program.

3. Responsibilities

- **Students:** Log in regularly, complete required time and lessons, stay focused, and ask for help when needed.
- **Teachers/Staff:** Provide access, monitor progress, and support students as needed.

4. Materials Needed

- A Chromebook, laptop, or tablet with internet access
- Student login credentials (username and password or Clever/ClassLink access)
- Headphones (for activities with audio)

5. Procedures

5.1 Logging In

1. Open a web browser and go to: https://www.lexiapowerup.com
Or log in through Clever/ClassLink if used by the school.

- 2. Enter your **username and password** or click the Lexia PowerUp icon from your school's portal.
- 3. If logging in for the first time, complete the **initial placement activity**.

5.2 Daily Use Guidelines

1. Time Expectation:

- Use Lexia PowerUp at least 3–5 days per week for 20–40 minutes per session. At minimum 8 units per week.
- o Follow your teacher's schedule and instructions for when to log in.

2. Work Independently:

- Try each activity on your own first.
- Use headphones and stay focused.

3. Use Tools and Hints:

- o Pay attention to instructions, examples, and hints in the program.
- Use the repeat button if needed.

4. Ask for Help if Stuck:

o Raise your hand or notify your teacher if you need help after several tries.

5.3 Staying On Track

1. Complete Activities in Order:

- o Follow the program's sequence. Don't skip around.
- Work through the three strands: Word Study, Grammar, and Comprehension.

2. Log Out Properly:

Always click the log out button when done to save your progress.

6. Rules and Expectations

- Do not use Lexia PowerUp for chatting, gaming, or off-task behavior.
- **Respect quiet zones**: Wear headphones and avoid distracting others.
- **Do your best** on every activity it helps the program learn what you need.
- Do not share your login with anyone else.

7. Help & Support

- If you can't log in or the program doesn't work:
 - Let your teacher know.
 - o Check your internet connection.
- If you're confused about an activity:
 - Try again, use hints, and then ask your teacher if needed. Tip: Check your resource wall.

8. Rewards and Progress

- You may earn certificates, classroom rewards, or recognition for reaching goals.
- Check with your teacher for your weekly or monthly goals and incentives.
