"ON THE RED CARPET AT THE OSCARS" (Pre Show)

AIRS SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2019, 4:30-6:30 p.m. ET/1:30-3:30 p.m. PT Live red carpet coverage kicks off with the return of "On the Red Carpet at the Oscars" at 4:30 p.m. ET/1:30 p.m. PT, hosted by ABC7 L.A.'s veteran Entertainment Reporter George Pennacchio. Stationed at the first live interview position on the red carpet, Pennacchio will chat with this year's nominees, presenters and special guests as they arrive on the red carpet that leads into Hollywood's Dolby Theatre. From OTRC's exclusive balcony over the Oscar red carpet, OTRC's fashion experts have a bird's eye view for candid red carpet commentary. ABC stations are responsible for clearing network programming.

"ON THE RED CARPET AFTER THE AWARDS" (Post Show)

AIRS SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2019, approx. 11 p.m.-1 a.m. ET/8-10 p.m. PT Immediately following "The Oscars," "On The Red Carpet After the Awards" lets viewers in on what happened backstage during the awards. The post show also takes viewers to invitation-only celebrations across Los Angeles to party with the night's big winners as they arrive at the Governors Ball and other star-studded celebrations. The OTRC fashion experts wrap up the night with their final fashion analyses on the red carpet hits and misses. ABC stations are responsible for clearing network programming.
