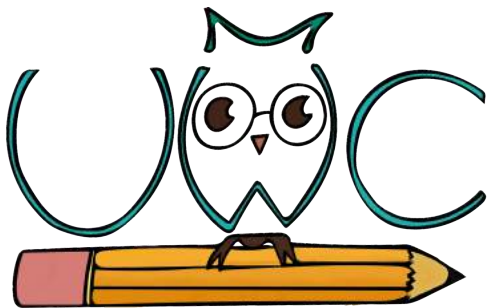

WHY ARE WE HERE?

Our goal is to offer support to all students in developing written and verbal communication skills, at any level of study and in any discipline, in a welcoming facility set aside for this purpose. We also offer support to the faculty members of DBU, as professors strive to illuminate the importance of students' concrete writing abilities.



MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR VISIT

- Make appointments at least a day in advance. Walk-ins are welcome on a first-come, first-served basis
- Bring the professor's directions and any work already accomplished for the assignment
- Visit early in the writing process to allow time for revision Consider the consultant's words as advice, not authority
- Ask for clarification and explanation throughout the session

WHAT DO WE DO?

We want all clients to become confident in their writing abilities. In that spirit, students may bring any writing assignment to the UWC for a consultation. We can assist writers in building up their skills by:

- Brainstorming with the author
- Strategizing flow and organization
- Assessing grammar and punctuation needs
- Helping with formatting
- Providing a variety of resources for applying correct words, structure, and other academic elements

In order to best benefit students, we limit our involvement with original work to ensure that the content belongs entirely to the student.

- Consultants share editing tips with clients but never mark on their papers
- Grammar assistance is limited to two pages or less to discover patterns students can improve upon
- Content and vocabulary must be contributed by the client

WHO IS HERE TO HELP?

Our writing consultants are DBU students or graduates who experience and understand the pressures you face each semester. They are extensively trained, internationally certified, and required to meet high qualifications such as strong academic standing, excellent leadership abilities, and effective communication skills.
