- The foundation was established in 2012 by professional baseball player Anthony Rizzo and his family.
- Hope 44 Fund: The foundation's signature program, the Hope 44 Fund, provides financial assistance to families battling cancer, offering support for medical expenses, transportation, and other essential needs.
- Hospital Partnerships: The Anthony Rizzo Family Foundation collaborates with leading medical
  institutions, including Lurie Children's Hospital and Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital, to fund research
  and enhance patient care.
- Patient and Family Support: In addition to financial assistance, the foundation offers emotional support and resources to children and families facing cancer diagnosis and treatment.
- Annual Walks for Cancer: For 12 years, the foundation has hosted annual walks to raise funds and awareness for pediatric cancer research and patient support services.
