
Roster Server Setup:


- 1. Select the Apps tab
- 2. Click +ADD



3. Search for "McGraw Hill Educational Access Manager McGraw-Hill Digital Platform"



- 4. Click Add
- 5. Select **Permission Type:**
 - Rule-Based Permissions:
 - Allows you to choose permissions based on roster data
 - Recommended
 - Full Permissions:
 - Sends all student and teacher data to application
 - Legacy Custom Permissions:
 - Builds dependencies based on orgs and courses



- 6. Search the Mcgraw Hill Application
- 7. Click Enable *NOTE: This will not affect your live data

Prepping McGraw Hill Education Single-Sign On (SSO) Setup:

- 1. Open Classlink Console Management
- 2. Click Add and Assign App
- 3. Click **BLUE** App Library
- 4. Search "McGraw Hill ConnectED SSO" App
 - NOTE: There are multiple McGraw Hill Apps, please check wording carefully
- 5. Click Add
- 6. Click Add and Assign App
- 7. Search for install "McGraw Hill ConnectED SSO" App
- 8. Click the 3 dots at the end of "McGraw Hill ConnectED SSO"
- 9. Click Copy
- 10. Delete the old "McGraw Hill ConnectED SSO"
- 11. Click the 3 dots on the new copy of "McGraw Hill ConnectED SSO"
- 12. Click Edit
- 13. Click Form Post With Extension dropdown
- 14. Select LTI 1.0
- 15. Click Save
 - NOTE: This application will not be functional until **ALL** steps of the integration are complete
- 16. Send confirmation email that your setup has been completed
