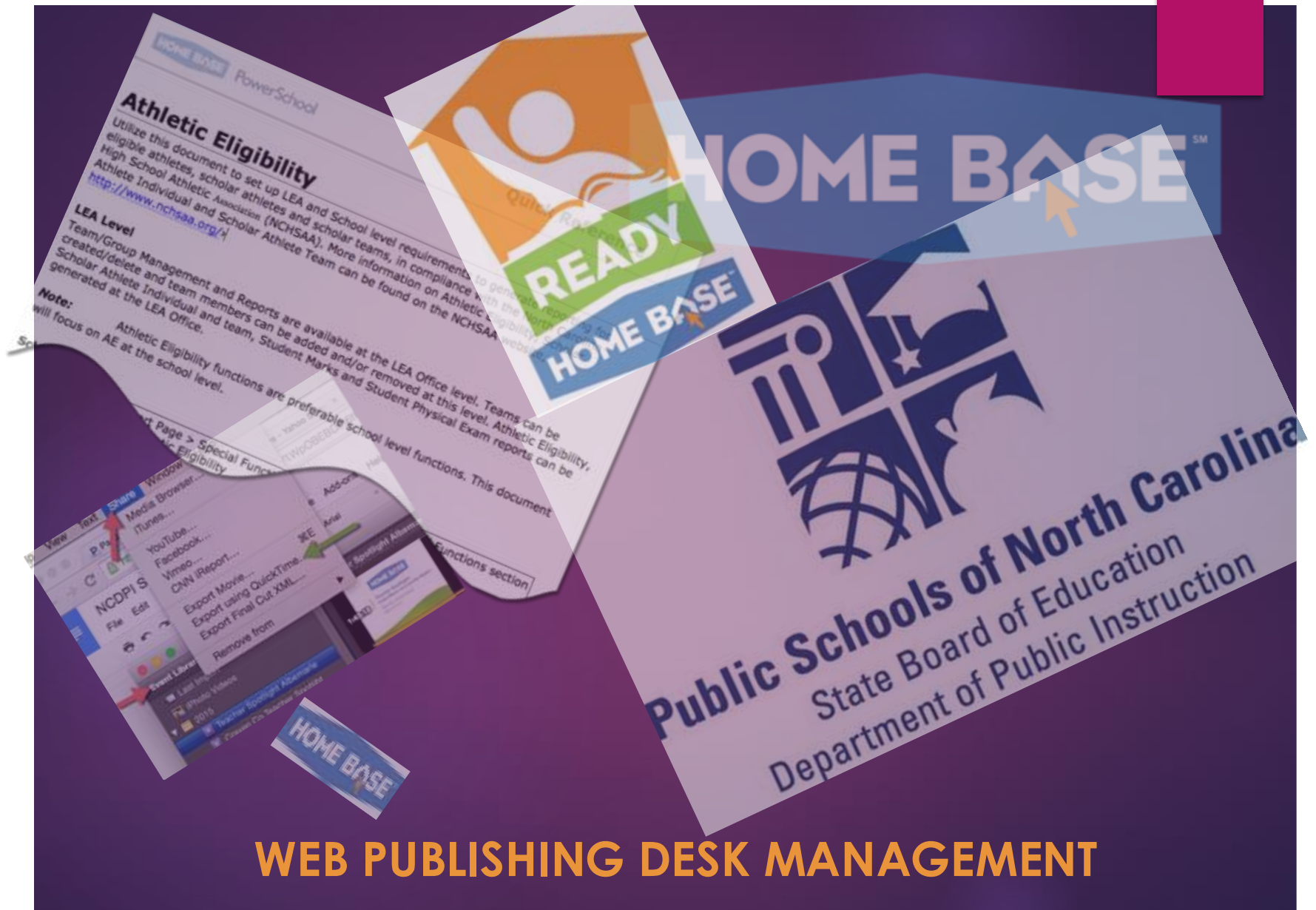

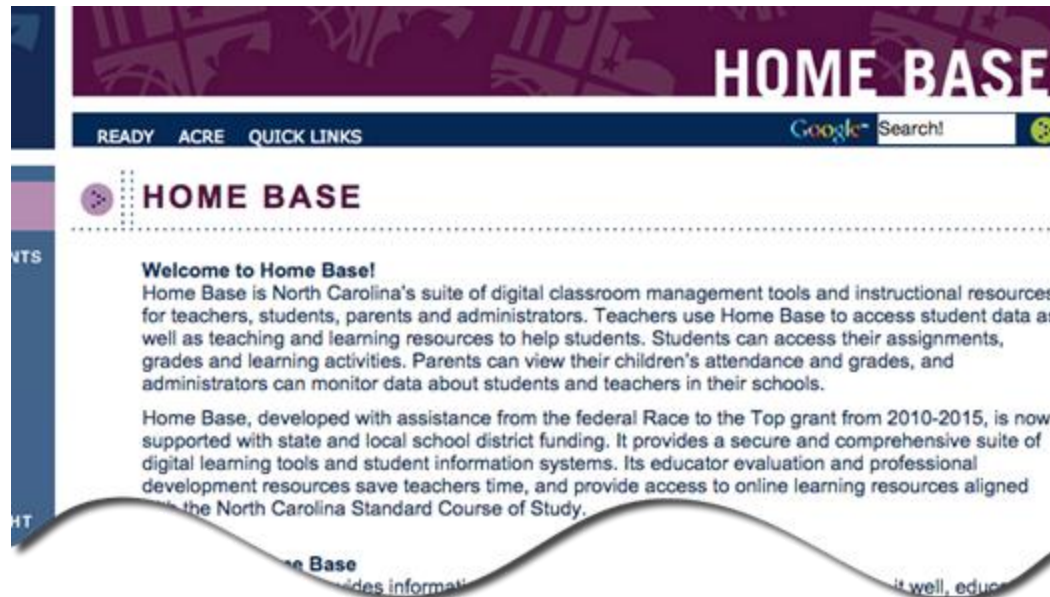

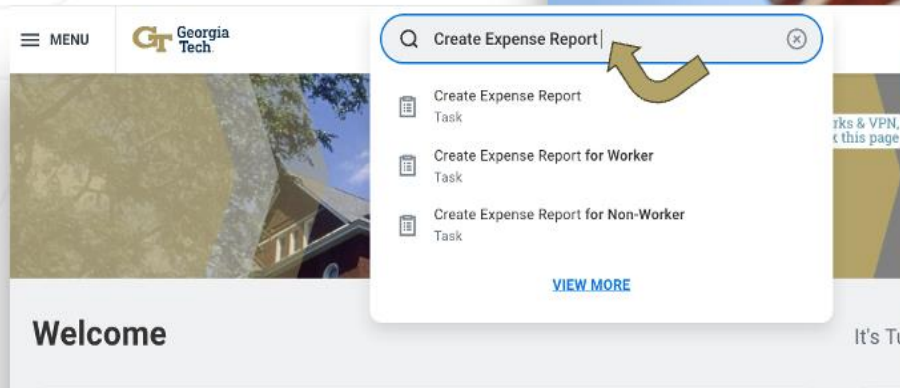

Greek Village: A New Chapter in a Longstanding Tradition

For more than half a century, Fraternity Court has stood as a cornerstone of NC State's Greek life—a place where friendships took root, traditions thrived, and campus leaders first found their voice. Originally built in 1964, the Court served as home to many of the university's fraternities. Over the years, it gradually welcomed women's organizations, and by the early 2000s, its name evolved to reflect a more inclusive spirit: Greek Court.

New District
You can now designate resources in Schoolnet at the district level as "All District" for district approval, them among all districts in NC. As schools submit teacher work through Schoolnet to all other districts in the state, districts will now have the option to make those resources available to all other districts in the state. Resources created at the school or district level can also be shared among districts. This means you will be able to showcase and share your teachers' and curriculum leaders' work, not only within your own district, but across all districts in North Carolina. This option is now available, in addition to the Submit to State option as another way NC teachers and leaders can share instructional resources statewide. We hope you will take advantage of the ability to showcase the work being done in your district and the opportunity to share with your peers.

Teachers Can Connect with Parents through Home Base & PowerSchool

- 1 Provide "Real-time" Data**
Input student grades throughout the quarter. Parents grow less anxious when they can see their students' progress. This can save time for parents and teachers in face-to-face conferences.
- 2 Parent Portal How-to's**
Provide parents with helpful how-to links during Back to School Night so that they know how to link to their students' accounts. Parents can login to PowerSchool through the Parent Portal where they can view students' grades and attendance.
- 3 Explain Weighted Assignments**
Explain to parents how assignments are weighted for your students.
- 4 Use Specific, Detailed Language**
Use unique, specific descriptions in PowerSchool. You can include standards covered by an assignment ensuring parents are on track with their student's core standards plan. Use the section description to uniquely describe the class, link to syllabus/other online resources and as a place for reminders/important information.
